### INTRODUCTION

At the Juraj Šižgorić Public Library in Šibenik, on June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019. The Open Day of the BLUEKEP Project - Knowledge Exchange and Integration of the Education System in the Cross-Border Area, located in the Šibenik-Knin County in consortium with other Croatian and Italian organizations, was held by the Public Institution Development Agency of Šibenik-Knin county. On this occasion, their experiences were exchanged in Italy, which divided students as well as peers and professors who participated in the project.

At the outset, the project itself and its impact were presented by Ms. Karmela Crnica and Ms. Mira Lepur, as representatives of the PP4. The introductory words were followed by presentations by students who highlighted their experiences in the exchange. All the students who participated in the project emphasized that this was a valuable experience, both in teaching and in the practical part, as well as in the private sense of getting acquainted, with all present students recommending participation in similar programs during their education.

The Open Day of the BLUE KEP project in Šibenik is organized in 2 parts:

1. ORAL AND VISUAL PRESENTATION presenting experience of participating in a mobility program using a Power Point presentation of students. Also, each participant received a promotional leaflet and a booklet of the BLUEKEP project containing all the essential information.
2. ASSOCIATION OF INTERESTED STAKEHOLDERS in the premises of the Juraj Šižgorić City Library with a convenient finger catering. In this section, the interested public and the media could learn something about the project itself, the organization, the impressions of the students and the teachers.

### **THE GOAL OF AN ORGANIZED EVENT**

The aim of this event is to raise awareness among students, teachers and local businesses in their high economy and to promote international mobility for learning as one way of gaining relevant skills and experience.

Targeted audience with technical and nautical students and blue industry students, but also interested public.

### **RESULTS**

The students of Traffic-Technical School Šibenik were in the school of I.S.I.S. Nautico Tomaso di Savoia Duca di Genova in Trieste, where they took classes in English and Italian in professional subjects: Navigation, Electromechanics, Logistics and Maritime Law. They have done their professional practice at OCEAN S.r.l. in Trieste on the Bat and Rasant tugboats. The professional part of the division consists of map work, boat charting, fire drills and tow barges in Monfalcone and Koper. They had the opportunity for the school ship "Umberto d'Ancona" to do the exercise of night navigation and determine the positions of the ship to use a sextant. What the students highlighted as the fondest memories and experiences were new friendships, but they also mentioned the tugboats crew because, although they were "just students", they were accepted as an equal part of the crew. In their spare time, they were introduced to the sights of Trieste, Muggie and Venice.

The students of the Technical School Šibenik have spent for 45 days in the Italian city of San Benedetto del Tronto in the Marche region, more precisely in the school I.I.S. Fazzini-Mercantini. They did their professional internship at a private company, CRM, where they had the opportunity to testify and program Blue Fisher fishing equipment, as well as at Navaltecnic's private shipyard. In addition to teaching activities and professional practice, students also took the opportunity for extracurricular activities. Like colleagues from other schools, they had positive experiences.

The students of the Industrial and Crafts School Šibenik exchange spent at the I.S.I.S. Brignoli-Einaudi-Marconi School in Staranzana. They were also part of the GO & LEARN program, accompanied by tutors visited various companies (mareFVG from Monfalcone, Wärtsilä from Trieste, Monte Carlo Yacht from Monfalcone and Arsenal from Trieste). Professional practice has been done at Monte Carlo Yacht in Monfalcone. The students pointed out that Italian education is developed, that they were better equipped and had much more practice.

All students, as well as their professors and equals, are satisfied with the achievement and will hope that co-operation between schools as well as student exchange will continue. Positive experiences and new friendships are something that will carry with them forever and carry on.

- Students from 2<sup>nd</sup> grade of marine electricians from Industrial and Crafts school Šibenik - Dario Baranovic, Luka Labor and Lucian Spanja, attended classes at the I.S.I.S. "Brignoli - Einaudi - Marconi" from Staranzano and students have completed their internship at Monte Carlo Yacht in Monfalcone;

- Students from 3rd grade of Shipbuilding Technicians from Technical school Šibenik - Kristijan Vodan and Marko Žaja attended classes at I.I.S. Fazzini-Mercantini - Grottammare, and their professional practice was done at Naval Tecnica Shipyard and Centro radioelettrico maritime.

The aim of this project is, through the cooperation of Italian and Croatian educational institutions, to improve the exchange of knowledge and human resources and thus to positively influence the economic development of the whole cross-border area.

The total budget of the project is € 921,134.00, and the project partners are with the Public Institution Development Agency of the County of Šibenik-Knin, which implements the project in the area of the County of Šibenik-Knin, Informest from Friuli Venezia Giulia; Marche Region; Adriatic-Ionian Euroregion; County of Istria and Public Institution RERA SD from Split-Dalmatia County.
