

City of Pazin is Administrative center of Istrian County in Croatia, with 8.638 inhabitants.

Main City office covers activities related to international cooperation and European funds, while Department of communal system, physical planning and construction, in their scope, deals with environmental protection and public utilities. Department of administration and social affairs is in charge of cultural activities, protection and valorization of cultural heritage. Department of economy, finance and budget is in charge of Annual budget and economy affairs such as tourism.



Public Open University - POU Poreč is a public institution established in 1960, dedicated to culture and education. Its Departments of Music and Theatre, Visual Arts, Cinema, and Education provide the citizens of Poreč with various artistic, cultural and educational programmes throughout the year, while nurturing amateurism in order to promote creativity and ensure better quality of life in the community. With a wide range of activities, the University plays the central role in the city's cultural life.



The **Town of Crikvenica** is a local government located on the coast of the Adriatic sea. The Town Administration has 38 employes in three departments; one in charge of finance, tourism and economy, one in charge of communal infrastructure, urban planning, environmental protection and assets, and one in charge of social welfare, education, sports, health care and local government. Crikvenica celebrates its Town Day on August 14 every year - the day when the name Crikvenica was mentioned for the first time in an offical document in 1412. This year, Crikvenica celebrates 130 years of tourism.

I-Archeo.S.

The Project represents the capitalization of "Archeo.S." Project, funded by IPA Adriatic CBC Programme 2007-2013, in which Teatro Pubblico Pugliese, Abruzzo Region and Grad Pazin have cooperated, and that had the objective to analyze the issues concerning the enhancement of cultural heritage and to develop innovative models of governance.

I-Archeo.S will capitalize on:

- the methodology of valorization of the Cultural Heritage as defined in Archeo.S, i.e., by means of artistic, cultural & creative productions;
- the successful experience of the stakeholders working together as a "System".

The Overall Objective of the Project is to build an Integrated System of Services for the Natural and Cultural Heritage, for a sustainable economic development. Therefore, the specific objectives of the project are to connect various economic stakeholders and strengthen their skills, to increase the attractive value of the lesser known tourist destinations and to create new tourist itineraries to deseasonalize tourist flows.

I-Archeo.S is conceived as a rational path of cooperation in which the Partnership and a "Pool of Experts" in sociology, creative economy and territorial and tourism marketing, such as Danijel Bertović, Rossana Cotroneo, Ottavia Ricci and Michele Trimarchi, will accompany stakeholders in the creation of a Public-Private Cluster (with a minimum duration of 5 years) in each of the 6 involved territories, in order to promote the economic potentials of the local cultural and environmental resources, with the objective to increase the quality of services offered, integrate territorial services and transform, or simply strengthen, them into new tourist destinations, respecting their conservation and the sustainability of interventions.

Stakeholders involved will be: *SMEs, Public Bodies from* the fields of sustainable tourism, management of Natural & Cultural heritage, agro-food, handcraft, culture and creativity.

PILOT ACTION

Each Partner together with its Public-Private Cluster will develop its thematic itinerary which will be conceived as **new creative products** (e.g. eco-routes, new intermodal plans, alternative ways of transportation, edutainment products, storytelling) that will combine innovation, multidisciplinary approaches to promote values expressed by Natural and Cultural Heritage.

The **Pilot Action** will be the occasion to test the itineraries which will be presented as Educational Tours dedicated to International Tour Operators.

TRANSFERABILITY and IMPLEMENTATION PLAN of Outputs and results

At the end of the Project the Pool of Experts will develop the document that describes the methodology adopted to create the new model of cooperation between public & private actors for a sustainable economic development. It will include guidelines to facilitate the implementation of that model by other organisations/regions/countries outside the current partnership.

A MOBILE APP will be created to improve the accessibility and fruition of the Cultural and natural heritage sites included in the tourist thematic itineraries. It will include all the services provided by the Public-Private Clusters of I-Archeo.S and that will also include suitable contents for people with disabilities.
