Summary

Scuola Centrale Formazione has organized the final cycle of events of the project in Venice and some networking activities around the KeyQ+ Point in Pramaggiore (VE) and the KeyQ+ Itinerary in Veneto. This latter networking activities were planned and carried out with the cooperation of SCF's member Lepido Rocco, as part of its actions of animation of the KeyQ+ Point in Veneto (Pramaggiore). Those networking activities were targeted to stakeholders whom were previously involved in the project (the ones who signed the Memorandum of Understanding but not exclusively). The experiential tour of the Caorle lagoon and the visits to cultural interest points in the area has been "warm-up activities" to start the mutual knowledge of stakeholders and PPs from other regions. In the afternoon the program was dedicated to a "world cafè" around the project and its future perspectives. The final conference was held at Cà Foscari, "Aula Mario Baratto" in Venice – Dorsoduro. The Managing Authority, the regional authorities from Veneto, Emilia Romagna and Istria, but also local authorities from Emilia Romagna, Veneto, Friuli Venezia Giulia and Istria were present at the final conference in Venice, together with other guests and stakeholders from Italy, Croatia and Slovenia.

From Istria the following stakeholders took part in the final cycle of events: Ezio Pinzan (Assessor for Agriculture, Forestry, Hunting, Fishery and Water Economy - Region of Istria) Nikola Vuković (chef of the restaurant "La Grisa"), Sandi Siljan (professor of School of Tourism, Catering and Trade Pula) and Roberto Zović (professor of the School of Tourism, Catering and Trade Pula).
