Introduction

Public Events activity (2.4) concerns public events organization and hosting with overall objective to achieve involvement of the identified stakeholders. All relevant target groups will be identified (citizens, technical experts, journalists, institutional stakeholders) and each group will be addressed through dedicated communication tools, events such as meetings, ad-hoc seminars, conferences, focus groups, press releases. The partnership will try to involve members of EUSAIR TSG for Pillar 2 in the events to present results and check their compliance with EUSAIR priorities. The CHARGE Final Event has been conceived as the foremost moment for disseminating the project results, good practices and lessons learnt, gathering the whole partnership with a varied audience of stakeholders and relevant actors.

1. CHARGE Final Event

The CHARGE Final Event has taken place on the 19th of September 2019 at the “Sala Marconi” of the Central Adriatic Ports Authority.

The Conference has been an opportunity to share the main results of the CHARGE project, whose aim is to improve the intermodal services within the existing maritime connections between the two shores of the Adriatic Sea and to optimize the efficiency of the traffic flows and the environmental sustainability in the framework of the Adriatic Ionian Macroregion.

After the welcoming speeches given by Ms. Manuela Bora, Regional Councillor of Marche Region, and Ms. Ida Simonella, City Councillor Municipality of Ancona, the conference has given the floor to Mr. Rodolfo Giampieri, President of the ADSPMAC, who has introduced the audience to the importance of the project and the future implications the latter will have.

Right after this introduction, Ms. Diana Gracin Petrović from the Joint Secretariat of the INTERREG Italy – Croatia Programme has taken stock of the current status of the Programme.

The second session has been finally focused on the project results, which have been disclosed by Arianna Norcini Pala (Manager European and National Programmes at RAM), Toni Maričević (Ministry of Sea, Transport and Infrastructures of Croatia, Maritime Security Dept.), Luigi Trevisan (North Adriatic Sea Ports Authority) and Ana Matulić (Split Port Authority).

The conference has been followed up by two round-tables. The first one with a focus on the Motorway of the Sea and its future strategy for the Adriatic Sea. The second one has instead given room to the study “Passenger traffic for relaunching connections between the shores of the Adriatic Sea” presented by Anthony La Salandra from “Risposte e Turismo”.

Facts and figures revealed by this study fed the final debate, where many stakeholders from the public and private sector exchanged their views on future strategies to be developed for relaunching ship passenger transport.

The press coverage has been considerably high. A detailed description of all the released articles on the final event this is provided by the deliverables 2.2.1 (Publication in selected journals and conferences) and 2.2.2 (CHARGE Campaign on media).

59 people have attended the event, out of an expected audience of 70 attendees.
