1. Project overview

MOSES capitalizes the results of EA SEA-WAY project, aimed to enhance the accessibility and mobility of passengers

in the Adriatic area through the development of new cross-border sustainable and integrated transport services, and of the related infrastructures.

MOSES, acronym of Maritime and multimOdal transport Services based on Ea Seaway project, has as its primary objective the improvement of maritime and multimodal transport services between Italy and Croatia, aiming, through the capitalization of the results obtained with the EA SEA-WAY project, to improve the quality of cross-border connections in the name of sustainability.

The project has a total budget of € 1,185,385.00 (of which € 1,007,577.25 are the portion covered by the ERDF).

The project is fund in the framework of the first call for Standard + projects of the Interreg Italy-Croatia Cross-Border Cooperation Program 2014-2020. The project contributes to improving the quality, safety and environmental sustainability of the maritime and coastal transportation services through the implementation of a multi-modal route offer between the two countries.

The project also contributes to promoting the development of connections to the hinterland by improving passenger services at the port hubs and encouraging the provision of ICT solutions for reception, information and ticketing services.

In particular, it will carry out a pilot action and a feasibility study to increase sustainability on the maritime transport routes between Italy and Croatia, a prefeasibility study on infrastructural interventions at some ports of the project area and three pilot actions aimed at the sustainable connection of ports with the hinterland.
