SUMMARY

As per the project Application Form, PP3/ZAD was tasked with coordinating the organization of six hybrid round tables with target groups, where thematic scientific research results will be presented. These are the researches that were conducted previously throughout the Activity 5.2 *Enhancing natural & cultural heritage sites through research activities*.

Therefore, each of the six partners that were conducting their research (LP/DNC, PP2/SKC, PP3/ZAD., PP7/ER, PP10/MOL, PP11/TPP) were tasked with organizing a minimum of one round table, where the scientific research on joint cross-border natural and cultural heritage for improvement of heritage sites will be elaborated and discussed with target groups, and especially Local Communities of Practice.

The last round table was organized on June 30, 2023.

1. LP/DNC

LP/DNC has held its round table on June 23, 2023. The topic discussed and presented was thematic scientific research about gastronomy-related heritage of Ston and Pelješac. Findings were presented to the main stakeholders in pilot area, as well as to the main designer, Mr. Barišić of the concept of Rector's Palace and main supplier of the equipment in Rector's Palace, Mr. Jelačić.

Research realized in Ston area has demonstrated great connection of local residents and nature around them: they have not forgotten skills passed on through generations especially those related to agriculture, fishing and shell fishing.

However, in order to increase the accessibility of the gastronomy related heritage it is advisable to:

- Boost research, development and innovation programmes and projects;
- Involve creative and cultural industries to contribute to strengthening entire value chain from agriculture/fishing/shell fishing to tourism;
- Enable the engagement of the local community.

The interpretation centre of Adriatic heritage established in Ston is serving as a platform for all mentioned activities and as a referent beginning point to explore rest of the Pelješac area.



2. PP2/SKC

PP2/SKC organized two round tables.

The first round table - “Izrada tematskog znanstvenog istraživanja: Održivi razvoj kao potpora očuvanju baštine Jadrana (Pilot područje: Muzej na otvorenom “Murterske vedute”)” / “Development of thematic scientific research: Sustainable development in support of the preservation of the Adriatic heritage (Pilot area: Open-Air Museum “Murterske vedute”)” - was organized on July 15, 2022, at the Adriatic Business Center – ABC. A total of 10 participants attended the round table.



The second round table organized by PP2/SKC was held on December 14, 2022. The topic of the round table was “Muzej na otvorenom “Murterske vedute” – predstavljanje izrade tematskog znanstvenog istraživanja (projekt TAKE IT SLOW)” / “Open-Air Museum “Murterske vedute” – presentation of the thematic scientific research” and it took place in the Community centre JEDRO. A total of 15 participants attended the round table.



3. PP3/ZAD

PP3/ZAD organized two round tables.

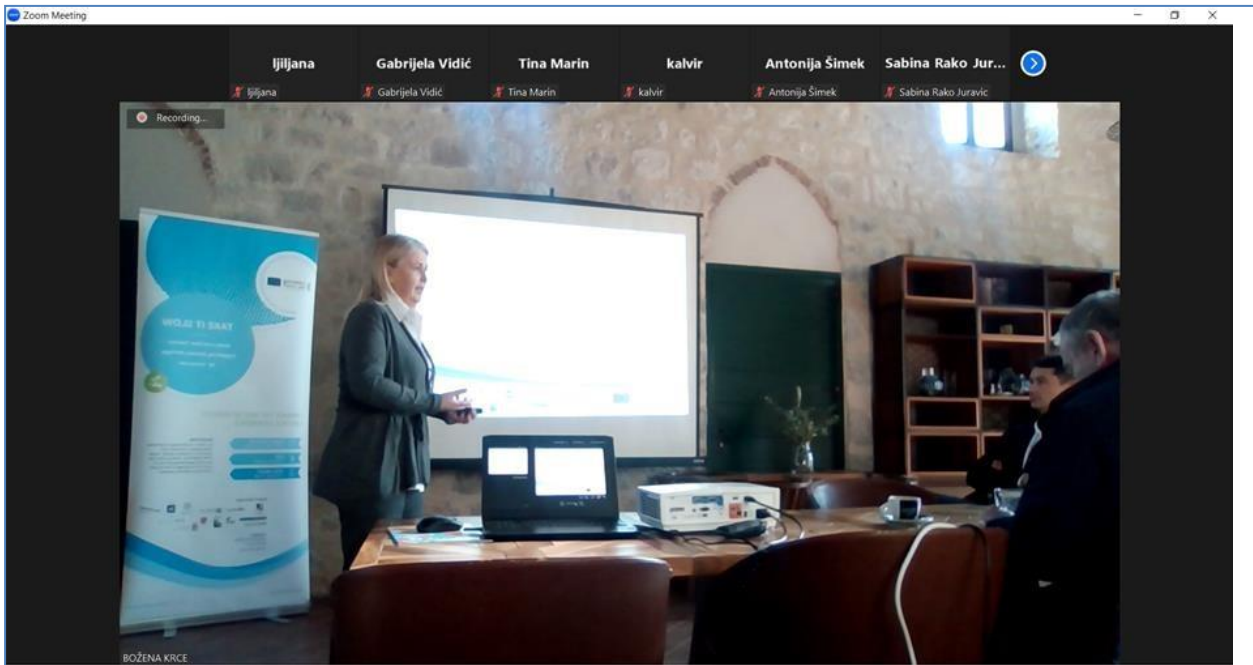
The first round table - “Turizam kakav želimo” / “Tourism as we want it” - was organized on September 26, 2022, at Uskok Sailing Club. A total of 40 participants attended the round table.



The second round table organized by PP3/ZAD was held on January 27, 2023. The topic of the round table was “Prezentacija prekograničnog strateškog okvira, akcijskog plana i smjernica za održivi razvoj turizma kreiranih u okviru projekta „TAKE IT SLOW“ te rezultata tematskog znanstvenog

istraživanja provedenog na području Ravni kotara” / ” Presentation of the cross-border strategic framework, action plan and guidelines for the sustainable development of tourism created within the framework of the project "TAKE IT SLOW" and the results of the thematic scientific research conducted in the area of Ravni Kotar” and it took place in the Heritage Hotel Maškovića Han. A total of 29 participants attended the round table.





4. PP7/ER

PP7/ER organized two round tables.

The first round table was organized on September 29, 2022, at Sala del Consiglio. A total of 24 participants attended the round table.

5. PP10/MOL

PP10/MOL organized one round table.

6. PP11/TPP

PP11/TPP organized two round tables.

The first round table was organized on November 5, 2021, at CiaiaLab - Urban Laboratory of Fasano. A total of 17 participants attended the round table.



The second round table was organized on November 18, 2021, at the Auditorium of the High School "GAETANO SALVEMINI" of Fasano. A total of 30 participants attended the round table.
