The second smart specialization workshop on the subject of smart specialization in green, slow and sustainable tourism was held on June 24th, 2021. The workshop was organized by the University of Zadar within the TAKE IT SLOW project. Its main goal was the dissemination of knowledge and best practices in smart specialization in the field of green, slow and sustainable tourism

The workshop participants had the opportunity to attend lectures prepared by Ms. Iva Tolic from the Institute for Development and International Relations and Ms. Maßa Klemenčić from the Slovenian Tourist Board. The first presentation was held by Ms. Tolic on the topic "Innovations in sustainable tourism". She explained the concept of sustainable tourism, what innovations in tourism mostly include, but she also gave examples of best practices of innovations in sustainable tourism worldwide, in the EU and the Adriatic-Ionian Region. Furthermore, she explained how the connective crisis has affected entrepreneurial innovations in tourism, but she also gave some guidelines on how innovation could be improved and better implemented in tourism.

The second presenter, Ms. Maía Klemenbie gave a presentation on the topic "Green & boutique products in Slovenian tourism". She talked about the Strategy for sustainable growth of Slovenian fourism 2017 – 2021, which has had the goal to improve recognizability and the image of the country, sustainable growth, and a higher added value. Ms. Klemenbie described the main principles of the green philosophy and the steps that had to be taken for the green transformation of Slovenian Within this transformation, Slovenia has implemented the Green Scheme of Slovenian tourism, with the National program for the development of sustainable tourism, a certification program, and a label for destinations and providers — Slovenian Green. As a result of continuous market research, Slovenian Tourist Board also started with the implementation of the Slovenian unique experiences brand and certificate, which represents a collection of unique, authentic experiences of premium quality, supporting the story of green bourdage Slovenia and the I feel Slovenia brand.

A new cross border cluster of sustainable, smart and slow tourism

100 best experiences of sustainable tourism gathered all over the Adriatic area, between Italy and Croatia

Aiming to build up a cluster of sustainable and slow products and services based on natural and cultural heritage. Veneto Region, as a partner of the European TAKE IT SLOW project and task leader for the specific action, supported by all Partners gathered almost 100 best experiences from the entire project area, which involves 6 Italian regions and 5 Croatian counties.

The objective of the collection was to highlight how in each destination sustainability is being promoted and fostered, in Italy as well in Croatia, in the island, rural and inland areas, creating a big picture to prepare the path to improve the competitiveness of typical product and services of Adriatic region, by boosting creativity, innovation, flexibility and knowledge in new products and services development process.

Regarding the criteria adopted in the collecting process, experiences had to be related to and supporting sustainable and/or slow tourism, considering the first one as that form of tourism that meets the needs of travelers and host territories while protecting and enhancing opportunities for the future as well as slow tourism can be described as that one based on a special experience which tourist realizes in interaction with the local community, their natural environment, culture, tradition, customs, gastronomy, etc, considered in the context of sustainable and responsible tourism by respecting the specifics and needs of the local community, unlike mass tourism which most often neglects it. Furthermore, it wasn't mandatory, in experiences gathering, to be a proper tourism offer. For instance, they could be also an innovative business model, an app, or a digital system.

The result was a rich and varied overview of best practices, a wide-ranging survey that ranges from cultural to accessible, from adventure to gastronomy, from sport to education tourism, embracing plenty of stakeholders belonging to the public as well to the private sector, and bringing together different innovative approaches related to sustainability in tourism. This Cluster for smart, sustainable, and slow products will contribute to mitigating high seasonality pressure in the involved areas, raise the level of competitiveness on international markets, develop sustainable high-tech solutions for typical products and services, moreover supporting higher quality tourism.

Sandra Bic, the project coordinator, presented that one of the main project activities is equipping, and increasing the virtual accessibility and visibility of the House of Castles in Momjan, as a central place for the promotion of all strian castles and the promotion of the common northern Adriatic cultural heritage. The investment in construction works, as a prerequisite for the implementation of the project, was financed by the Region of Istria and the City of Buje. The castle house was designed as an innovative architectural marker that reinterprets the tower and palace of the castle, an artist-in-residence space, a visitor and creative center, and at the same time a virtual museum dedicated to both virtual and sensory impaired visitors.

"The ISTRIAN CASTLES - CASTELLI ISTRIANI - ISTRIAN CASTLES project is divided into two parts. The first one that we will talk about today relates to the scientific and museological part, and the second one, which will start in the fall, concerns the popularization of heritage. Most of the citizens do not know much about the castles, their number, or where they are located, therefore the intention is to popularize them, scientifically research them and present them museologically. What the Region considered fundamental was the establishment of the Castle thouse. In accordance with the region Cultural Strategy, we have several such centers, such as the House of Writers in Paain, the House of Frescoes in Dragud, the Center for Intargible Culture in Picho; and the Mediterranean Dance Genter in Svenindent, Kattela House is another such center that has been built and will be officially opened on July 22. In Momjain, next to Kattela Rotta, there is a house we call Stara mijekara, which has been completely renowated into a Kattela House that is, a Tunctional, multimedia center intended for guests, but
