In the framework of the Take It Slow project, the first project conference in Molise "Il Cammino delle 7 Chiese" will take place on Monday, 20th February 2023, in Campobasso (Molise), at Palazzo Ex Gil.

The Take It Slow project, funded by the Interreg Italy-Croatia Programme, aims to present the Adriatic region as a sustainable, innovative, and ecologically aware multicultural Mediterranean area with rich natural and cultural heritage that is best to be explored and experienced through the concept of slow tourism.

The conference, hosted in Campobasso, from Councillor for Tourism and Territorial Marketing of Molise Region, Vincenzo Cotugno, Director of Tourism Service, Mariantonella Di Ielsi, and the Regional Manager of the project, Maria Tirabasso, will present the visual identity of the trail "*Il Cammino delle 7 Chiese*" in synergy with Alessio Vitale, the external expert who worked on the idea and the realization of the logo.

The slow trail of "*Il Cammino delle 7 Chiese*", which is one of the pilot areas of the project, aims to promote the most important churches located in the Croatian linguistic minorities area in the 5 small towns in the south-east of Molise. The idea is to set-up a new touristic micro-destination that is sustainable, authentic and slow.
