PP5/PTFVG organized, in cooperation with the Local Folk Group Val Resia, on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> of June, a full day of activities in Val Resia: a particular place located in the middle of a regional natural park (Parco Prealpi Giulie) where the population, a community of Slav origin, preserves an ancient language and ancient traditions, unique in the context of Slavic speaking communities.


The School Manzini from San Daniele del Friuli ( a tourism school) had a specific project on if or how a destination can act for conservation of its nature and its culture ( material and immaterial heritage) in the same time.

So we organized different activities

- a guided visit along the naturalistic path *“The Enchanted Wood Route”* – FVG in Movimento 10.000 passi di salute
- a meeting with the local community representatives and visit to the Cultural Centre Rozajanska Kultürska Hiša
- a tasting of some traditional dishes
- a stage of resian dances guided by the folkloristic group

The experience for students was really unique: all of them participated actively and learned about the environment, traditions, and some words in the local language *“resiano”*
