Short description

Molise Region intended to organize a cross-fertilization meeting focused on the theme of 'Interreg.' This meeting was coordinated and arranged in close synergy with the Municipality of Termoli (a municipality along the 'Cammino delle 7 Chiese' itinerary). The event was organized within the framework of the Smartport project, funded by the INTERREG - IPA CBC Italy-Albania-Montenegro program. Smartport involves the ports of the Southern Adriatic and Ionian Seas with the aim of improving their energy efficiency.

As part of the Smartport project, the partner Municipality of Termoli was tasked with organizing a local engagement activity called the 'Round Table.' This event aimed to engage local stakeholders and revolved around the Termoli port system as a driver of environmental, economic, and social sustainability.

Regarding these latter two themes, Prof. Letizia Bindi (from the Centro BIOCULT) presented the Parish Map methodology, which forms the basis of the participatory process with the Croatian-Molisana communities. For the intervention on economic sustainability, Dr. Maria Tirabasso (project officer of the Take It Slow project) delivered a presentation related to the Termoli port as a local tourism development opportunity. Among the various case studies presented, the 'Cammino delle 7 Chiese' was featured with a presentation by the Molise WOW Association, located in Termoli, which also organizes guided tours in the Croatian-Molisana territory.
