

Cross-fertilisation Smart Heritage Promotion Round Table was organized as part of the activity of different fields between expert's cooperation development and organization of interdisciplinary events on 20th of October 2022 in the House of Castles in Momjan and online via zoom platform.

The discussion was opened with the presentation of the TAKE IT SLOW project as the culmination of several years' efforts in networking and increasing the accessibility and revitalization of Istrian castles by the Region of Istria, while the representatives of City of Buje stressed project benefits for the local community. Branko Bogunović presented Smart Action Plan and smart tools for heritage promotion and TAKE IT SLOW methodology for setting up organizational structures and processes for new generation visitor centres, which integrate numerous stakeholder groups and operate in hybrid profit and non-profit models.

As an example of the scientific-popularization-multimedia aspect of TAKE IT SLOW project publication Istrian Castles was presented, very significant for Istrian historiography, especially its medieval component, which is experiencing a kind of renaissance, establishing itself as a globally recognizable research horizon, as pointed out by Maurizio Levak.

Josip Banić, the author of publication Istrian castles, gave an overview of Istrian castles in the context of scientific valorisation and smart promotion with personal experience of working on a project. Although primarily aimed at achieving accessibility to the widest possible range of readers, project also developed archival research that led to new knowledge and interpretation in the context of the Istrian Middle Ages. In this way, the House of Castles, as a combination of scientific and cultural-tourism componenets, represents a model for smart tourist products development that distance itself from pure attractions and deepen the educational component.
