The second day of the conference was a study visit of the LP/DNC's pilot area, Ston on Pelješac with professional tour guide. The entire partnership got introduced with examples of tourist products from Ston and Pelješac. The most interesting thing for the participants of the meeting was the visit to the oyster farms in the Mali Ston Bay, which is a natural reserve known for its long-standing tradition of oyster (*Ostrea edulis*) and mussel (*Muytilus galloprovincialis*) cultivation.

Also, they visited the Interpretation centre, adapted part of Rector's Palace - the multifunctional hall where heritage elements are interpreted in a modular and innovative way.
