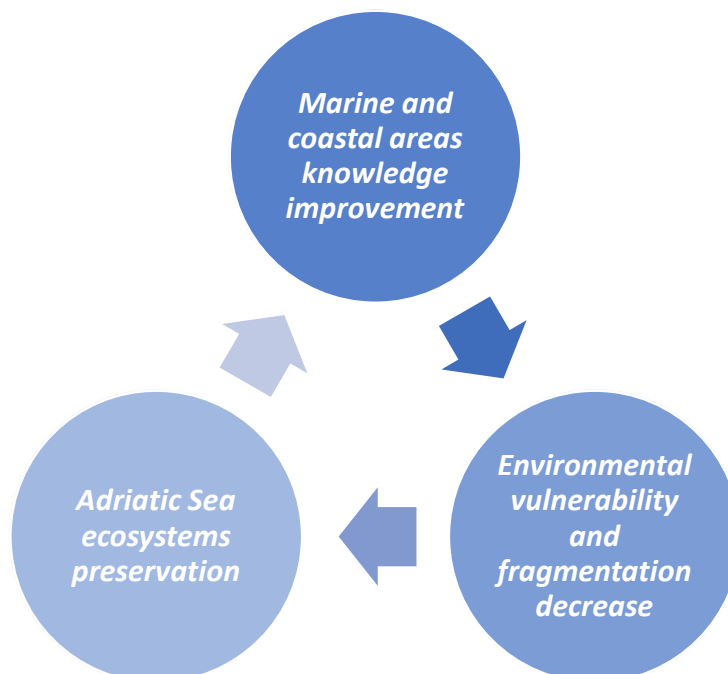
1. Introduction

1.1 Project CASCADe

Cascade project is a strategic project realized and financed in the framework of Italia Croatia programme 2014-2020 . It aims to develop a set of concerted and coordinated actions including monitoring (observing and modelling) and management (Maritime Spatial Planning - MSP, Integrated Coastal Zone Management - ICZM, Land-Sea Interaction - LSI) to enhance the knowledge and to evaluate the quality and assess the vulnerability of inland, coastal and marine ecosystems in Italy and Croatia with the final objective to restore endangered species and to support integrated management. The integrated modelling and observing systems will be developed to design and implement MSP/LSI/ICZM, management and restoration actions in 11 pilot areas.

Pilot actions will assess and protect coastal and marine biodiversity in degraded areas, set up restoration actions, assess the impacts of extreme events on ecosystems and understand how to avoid conflicts and boost synergies in the areas.

The project will consolidate long-lasting research capabilities in the field through a concrete dialogue with stakeholders and the participation of Agencies, research centres and universities in order to enhance inland, coastal and marine knowledge. Such shared information and monitoring protocols are essential for supporting concrete actions dealing with environmental vulnerability, fragmentation and safeguarding of ecosystem services at cross-border level.



In support of the specific project activities, CASCADe involves organizations, institutions, schools, trade associations, research centres, experts, and citizens, engaged various in the subject of biodiversity protection and enhancement, guaranteeing their involvement and active participation in the various Project initiatives.

1.2 The project's partnership

Project's partnership is constituted by 10 Italian and 6 Croatian partners and 4 associated partners, in a balanced mix of administration bodies, agencies, research centers and universities. The project, capitalising on previous experiences of the partners both in research and policy activities, will go beyond existing practices in the programme area, providing a useful blueprint for the setup of strategies and actions in the field of environmental protection.

The CASCADE project overall objective is to increase marine knowledge through the consolidation of inland and marine waters monitoring (observing and modelling) tools to address environmental vulnerability, fragmentation, and the safeguarding of ecosystem services, to support the protection of marine ecosystems and to develop science-based restoration methodologies and actions to assess the impacts of extreme events on marine ecosystems. In particular, CASCADE will concretely contribute to biodiversity protection in several Natura 2000 sites also providing monitoring tools, best

practices of restoration of endangered species and integrated management plans.

CASCADE main results will be to improve marine and coastal knowledge of Adriatic Sea, decrease environmental vulnerability and fragmentation, and safeguard ecosystem services. Additional results of CASCADE will consist on the development of capacity to support the protection of marine ecosystems. Final main result of CASCADE will be to assess the impacts of extreme events on marine ecosystems and develop science-based restoration methodologies and actions. These above mentioned results are strictly connected to CASCADE outputs, which aim to improve and develop of monitoring systems, to facilitate the access to monitoring data through an information system, to implement pilot actions focussing on restoration actions and improvement of integrated management systems, to engage stakeholders and improve capacity building through dissemination/communication/training activities/guided tours and scuba diving.

1.6 Project structure

From a technical point of view, project activities, organized in 3 technical WPs, clearly address to the identified challenges to reach the aims. Through subsequent and well connected tasks, characterization, monitoring and restoration/management actions are studied, implemented and tested. Including different pilot areas, the project will address biodiversity of habitats and ecosystems, allowing to refine the developed tools according to site specific characteristics and data needs

2. COMMUNICATION ACTIVITIES IN CASCADe PROJECT

2.1 Communication approach

CASCADe was aware of the potential and responsibility of cooperation projects with respect to the European Cohesion Policy, as stressed also by a communication of the EU Council (7896/17). Beyond the external target groups identified, CASCADe also took care of Programme and project-internal communication to ensure a coherent and coordinated project evolution. Communication contents has been based on bottom-up contributions by individual partners. A selection of project internal communication outputs has been integrated to Programme and external communication outputs. The interaction with stakeholders and general public was always strive to be bi-directional, in order to maximize involvement and feedback collection/implementation. In particular, the target group of coastal and marine professionals/institutions and under-40 citizens was part of the consultation process for the assessment of how CASCADe results and best practices were efficient and adequate for the territory and ecosystems protection and restoration.

Dedicated dissemination events was complement the communication strategy.

Effectiveness of communication strategy was be evaluated using different tools: according to the channels used, they included number of attendees or invited speakers in organized events, number of likes and shares in social media, number of visitors of project social pages, as well as number of bilateral meetings with key target groups.

All CASCADe partners actively contributed to the communication activities, led by IRB, and made sure that information about built capacities, results and developed products was effectively disseminated and received by target communities and stakeholders.

Some specific activities of partners included: stakeholders database, communication strategy, posts on social platforms and report of public events; press release and production of video or radio spots; submission of scientific journal papers.

The cross-border event ADRIATIC SEASIDE FESTIVAL has been concept as an itinerant review of events / widespread events that lead to the discovery of the pilot sites of Adriatic Coast involved in CASCADE project. Festival of Adriatic Sea has been coordinated by responsible of WP Communication for HR side and By DELTA 2000 for Italian side, with the support in particular of Lead partner Puglia Region and CMCC in particular for the first phase of activity definition.

The itinerant festival has been aimed to promote the activities of the project but also at conveying and disseminating information and contents capable of significantly impacting the levels of knowledge and behaviour of people, leveraging on empowerment and awareness of the importance of environmental values aimed at protecting, preserving and conserving the marine environment. The summer school was organized in Brindisi from 16 to 22 October 2022. The Summer School was organized in Italy, at Torre Guaceto and Palazzo Guerrieri in Brindisi. The school included participants from the CASCADe Consortium area. It dealt on the conservation, management and sustainable exploitation of the coastal and marine Adriatic areas. The summer school included also sampling sessions. Different topics were discussed such as: the Adriatic coastal and marine system: biodiversity, ecosystem functioning and service providing; the Adriatic coastal and marine system: the human environment (history, threats, value); the Adriatic coastal and marine system: Legislation, Management, Citizen Science.

Sessions about the pilot areas were also included. The aim of the summer school was to provide participants with an overview of the most innovative approaches relating to the knowledge, protection and management of ecosystems in the Adriatic area, with particular attention to transitional waters and the marine-coastal zone. This initiative had great relevance for the dissemination and communication goals of the CASCADe project. A particular focus (three dedicated lessons slots) was dedicated to each of the CASCADe Pilot Areas and on the achieved project results. Technical and practical sessions were organized in the field at the sites of Torre Guaceto and Saline di Punta della Contessa (Province of Brindisi, Puglia Italy, Pilot Area 3). The lessons (2 h each) were presented by both project members and guest scientists or field experts.

The total participants are been n. 21 students among which undergraduate students, PhD students and biologists, coming from different countries.

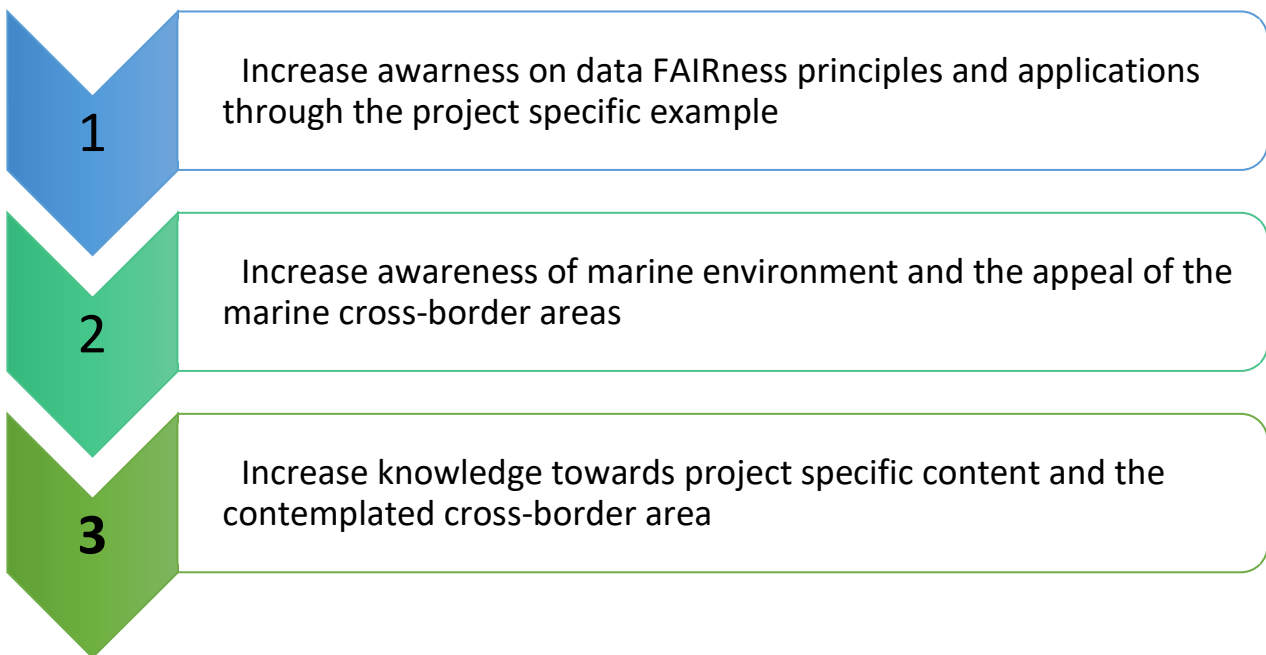

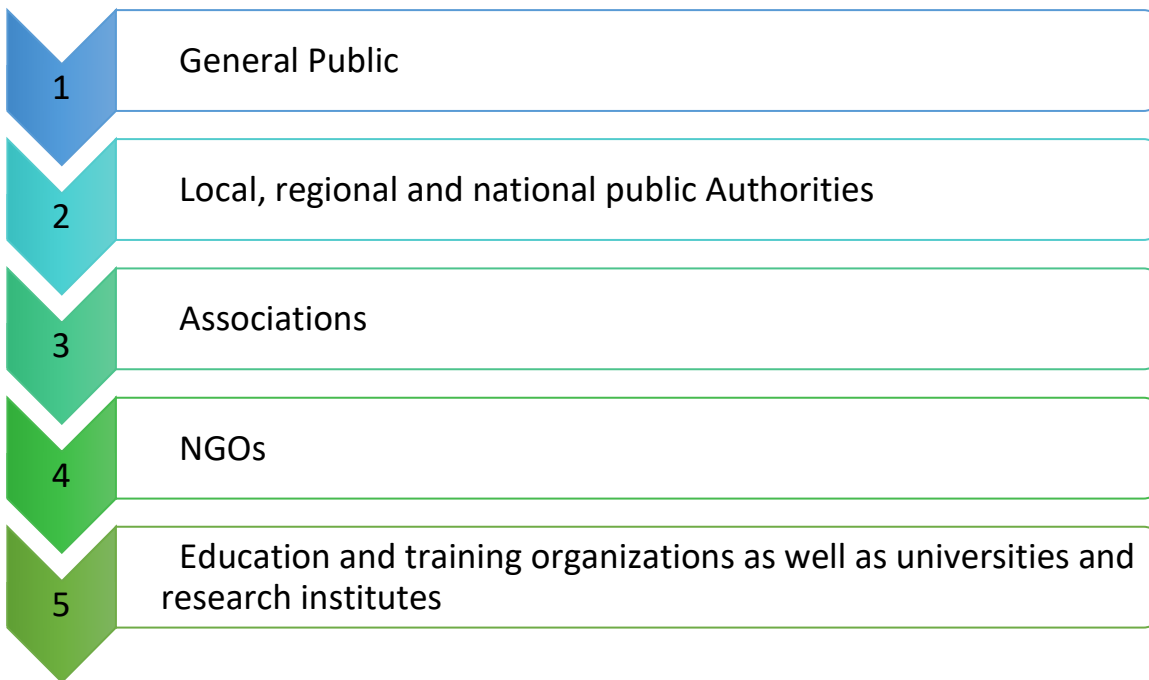
