Short description of the event:	Walk in the flooded forest of Punte Alberete with recognition of plants and animals.
Speakers speeches, brief summary and conclusion:	This guided tour was the perfect occasion to visit a protected natural oasis, placed about 10km north of Ravenna, and integral part of the Po Delta Park. The flooded forest offers a landscape unique in its kind: it is a very important wet area, which favours the growth of the avifauna, especially herons. Moreover, it hosts Italy's biggest colony of little egrets. Accompanied by the guide the attendee explored the forest, challenging themselves to recognize plants and trying to detect animals. It was a nice way to discover an area not so well known to the majority but with high relevance for the biodiversity of this area.

Short description of the event:	Observation of the sky led by Emanuele Cambiotti, an expert astrophile
Speakers speeches, brief summary and conclusion:	In the suggestive scenario of the garden of Casa Panzini the expert astrophile Emanuele Cambiotti held an observation of the sky. Starting from general information on stars, planets and astrophilism he gave an insight on his passion and work to the participants. It was possible to observe and also touch some precious and rare objects coming from the personal collection of the expert: flight plan, Beta Cloth, moon dust, fragments of meteorites. Mr. Cambiotti answered the numerous questions of the participants, who were very interested in learning about the history of the sky's observations and in listening to the stories and curiosities of the explorations and voyage around the world of the expert. During the night it was offered to all the participants the possibility to look at the sky through a professional telescope. Both adults and kids were thrilled to look at the sky with bare eye and then observe the same points with the help of the telescope: the shades and craters of the moon, saturn and its rings, Jupiter and star clusters.

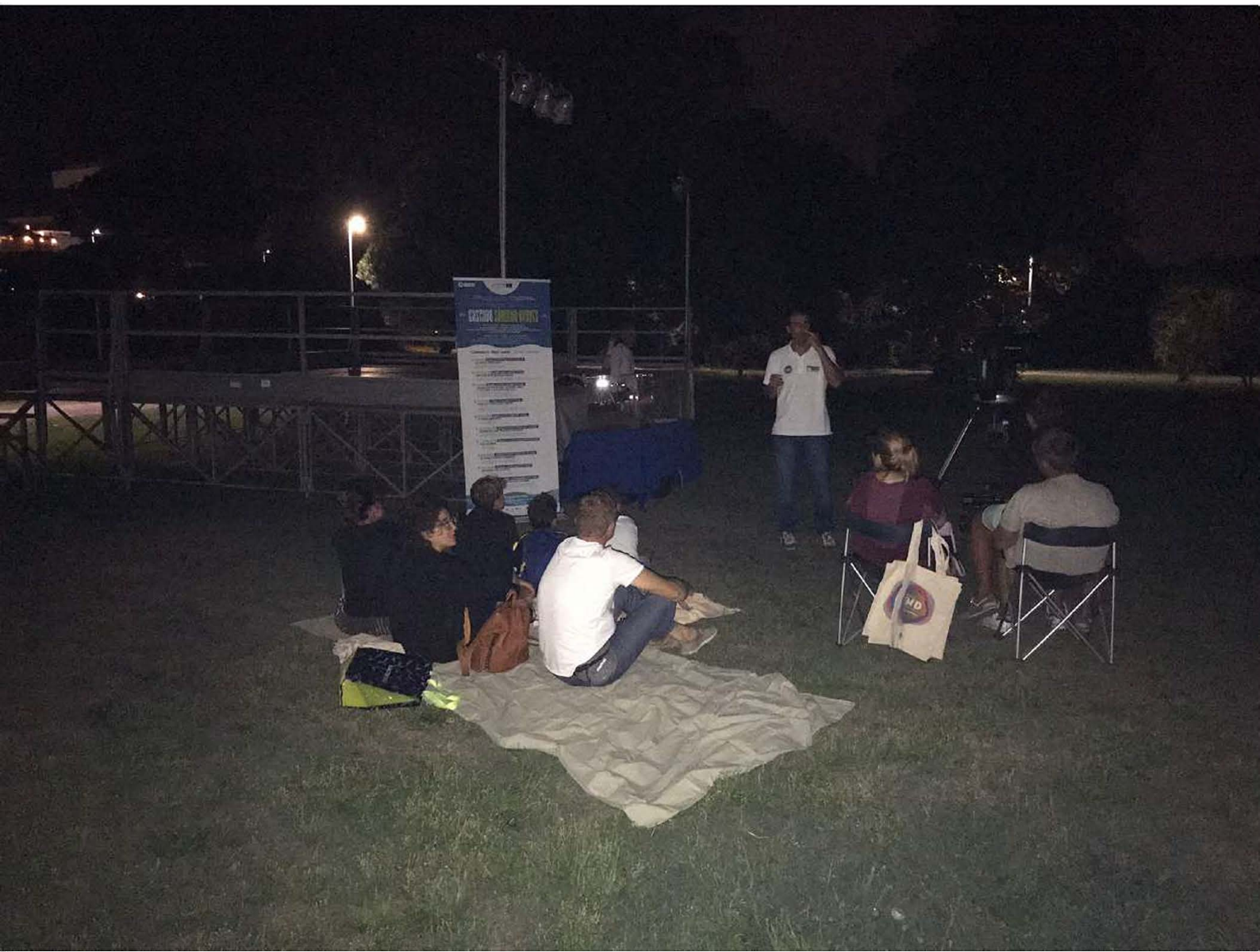

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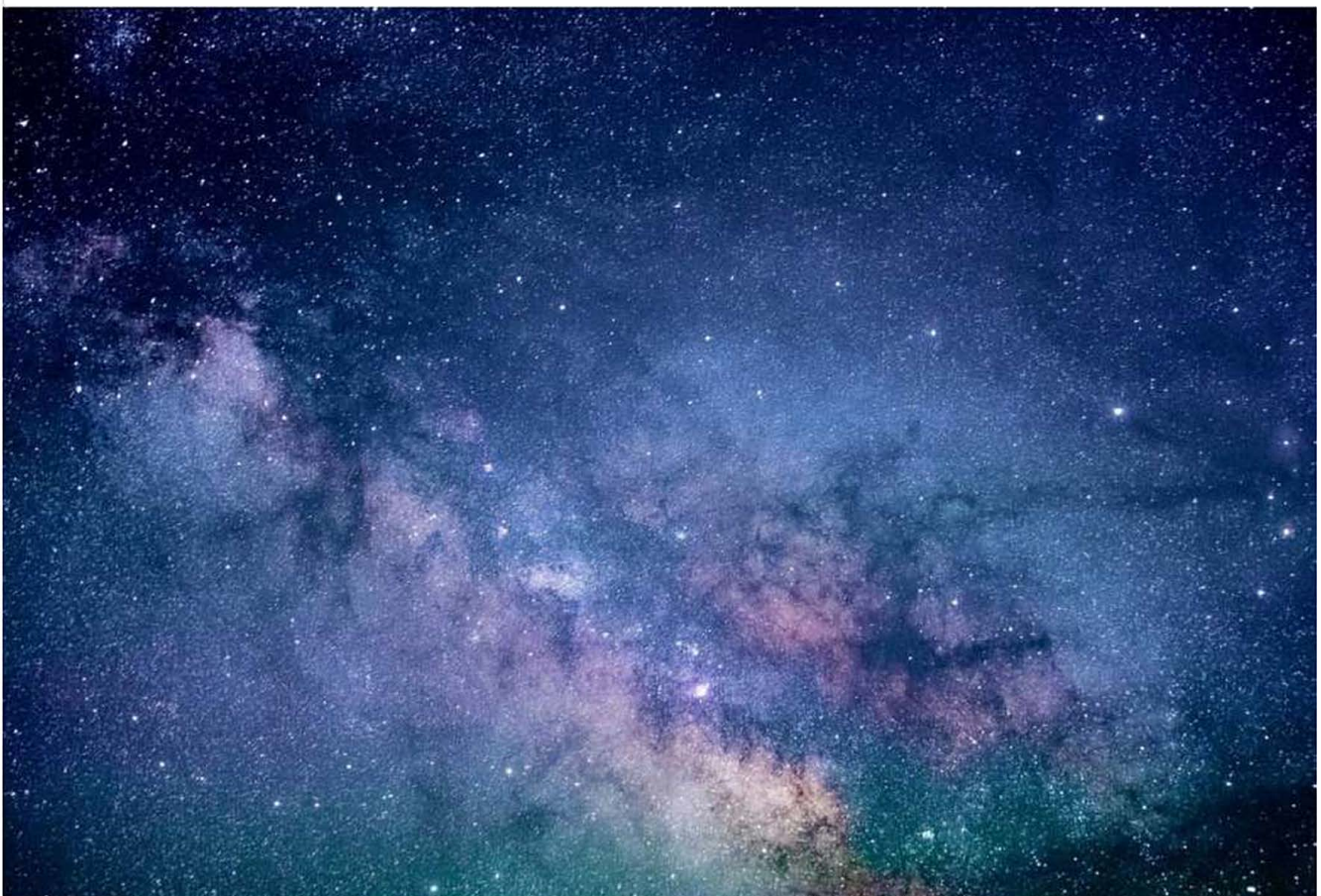

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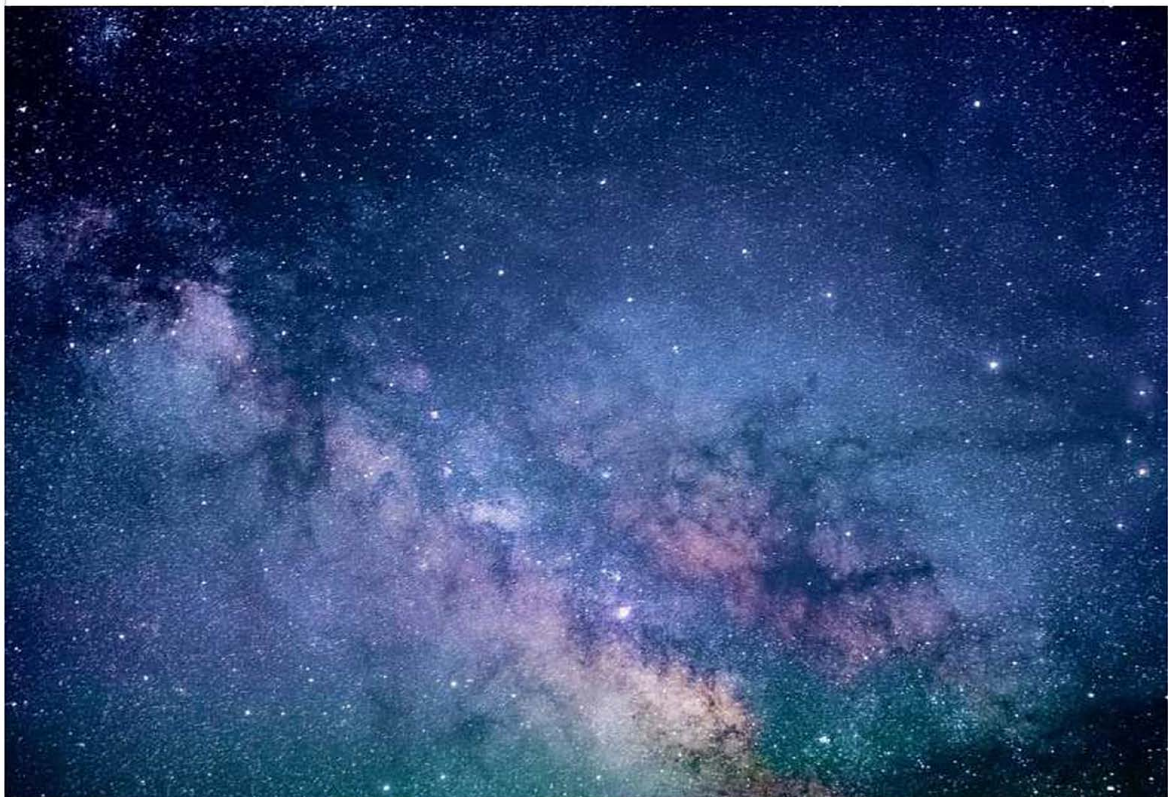

Short description of the event:	Clean-up day in the picturesque setting of the Bevano River mouth
Speakers speeches, brief summary and conclusion:	Following the directions of an environmental guide from the local association Natura, the participants joined the experts on a walk on the beach armed with a special equipment: gloves and bags for garbage collection. All the participants decided to attend the event because already sensitive to the topic of environmental sustainability and intrigued by the possibility of expanding their knowledge. During the walk on the beach they found traces of marine life such as shells, crabs, algae and woods, but the main subject of the hunt were the human traces: plastic bottles, cigarette, fishing nets, food wrappers and packaging. The item found allowed to have an insight on marine litter and their role as one of the main hazard for the environment, putting in danger the balance of the sea and the life of its inhabitants.

Short description of the event:	The second event of "YOU ARE WHAT YOU SEA " had the main aim to spread awareness of the Torre Guaceto MPA marine habitats to divers and to stimulate a dialogue and discussion about differences with other sites.
Speakers speeches, brief summary and conclusion:	Accredited and expert divers guided the participants to explore the seabed of the Torre Guaceto MPA where, among the coralligenous, bioconstructions originated by red algae bream, scorpion fish, hermit crabs, octopuses, shrimp, lobsters, starfish, urchins, groupers, and moray eels live. A lived experience to discuss the role and importance of actions to protect the marine and coastal environments of the Adriatic, to observe the effects of climate change in the MPA, to fight them and to preserve the good sea.

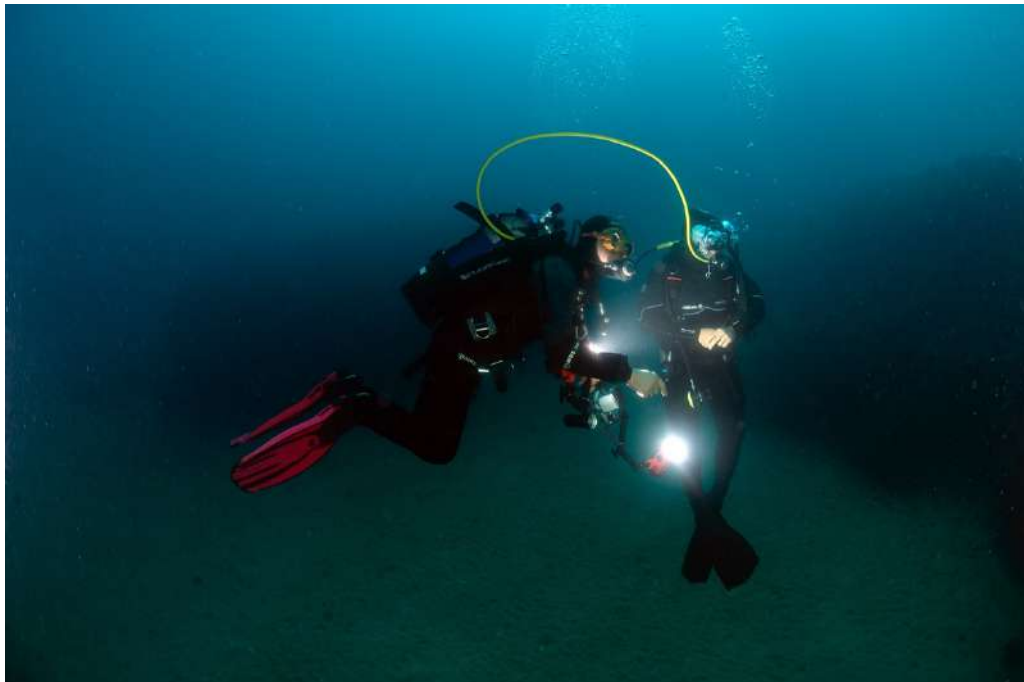

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

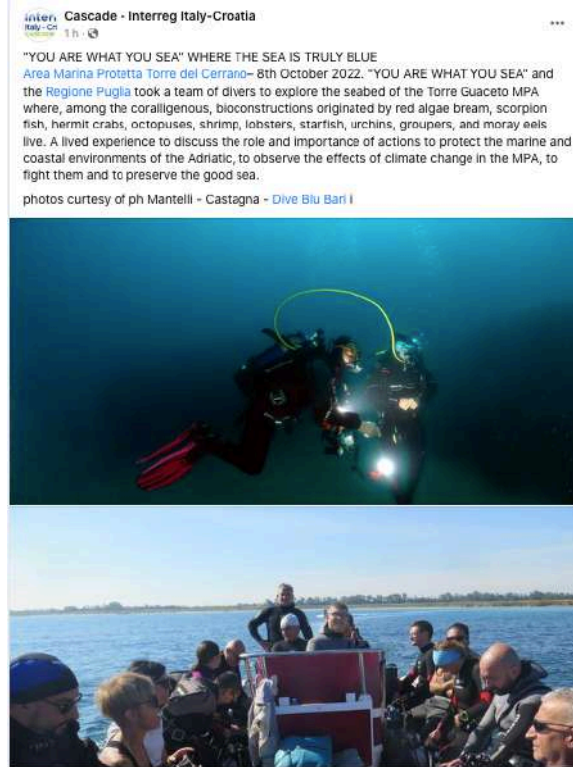
