Short description of the event:	Visit to the Recovery Centre, Care and Rehabilitation of Turtles with Fondazione Cetacea		
Speakers speeches, brief summary and conclusion:	The event was reserved for 23 the kids of the summer centre "insieme sotto al tiglio", who arrived at the location accompanied by three teachers. A marine biologist of Fondazione Cetacea made a brief lecture on the biology and anatomy of a sea turtle with the support of a life-sized model, also giving details on how human activities, fishing and climate change are putting their health at risk. It was possible to visit the Recovery Centre, Care and Rehabilitation of Turtles and observe the specimens in the tanks. The encounter with the living creatures was really appreciated by the attendees, also because some of them never had the chance prior to this visit to meet a sea turtle. They asked questions about the Foundation and decided to buy shirts and puppets from their merch to support them and their important work.

Short description of the event:	The children of the summer centre "Millepiedi" from Misano were involved in a step-by-step tracking to discover the most characteristic places of Portoverde.	
Speakers speeches, brief summary and conclusion:	The 52 children of the summer centre "Millepiedi" from Misano received a map of Portoverde highlighting the route to follow and some clues written in poetry in order to discover the most characteristic places of the area. Divided in three groups, each supervisioned by a teacher of the centre, they were allowed to walk around the small but characteristic centre of Portoverde trying to decrypt the clues and detect and reach the point of interest: the fountain, a piece of art resembling veils made with recycled materials, a church, the palace of tourism, and of course the touristic port with its peculiar circular shape. The kids had fun with this investigation game and also decided to make a challenge between them, with the fastest of the three teams awarded with free tickets for one of the parks of the Amaparco circuit.



Event type:	Guided tour		
Event venue:	Rimini - Via Destra del Porto		
Short description of the event:	Guided tour dedicated to discover the different fishing boats, learn more about the various fishing techniques and explore the historical places of the seafaring tradition of Rimini.		
Speakers speeches, brief summary and conclusion:	tradition of Rimini. The children of the summer centre of Rimini reached the meeting point: the lighthouse, a reference point for sailors and a symbol of the city, and then started the guided tour along the port canal in order to observe different fishing vessels as the expert explained their differences and purposes. They showed interest in understanding the variations of machinery and tools in relation to the type of catch, realising that the way of life of the fishes influences the choice of vessels and trails. There was also a traditional boat reconstruction which gave the chance to give an insight on the ancient Adriatic fishing culture. The children were more involved in the itinerary thanks to the support of an illustrated map showing the points of interest, and following it they realised how to reach the village of San Giuliano, the perfect example of how strong is the cultural heritage of the fishing activities for Rimini. Whilst hunting along its narrow and colourful streets the childrens found all the murales related to the sea that characterise San Giuliano and the tiles that celebrate the traditional navigation sails and boats used by the fishermen who lived there, having fun learning the history of their city.






Name of event:	Survey on the high sea
Date:	Monday 1 st August , 10.00 AM
Event type:	Lecture and laboratory
Event venue:	Cattolica - Free beach
Short description of the event:	Lecture on the sea and its inhabitants, with a focus on the hazard of plastic pollution. Active laboratory with the use of microscopes to observe shells and samples of plankton.
Speakers speeches, brief summary and conclusion:	The event was reserved for 44 of the kids of the summer centre "Millepiedi", who arrived at the location accompanied by three teachers. They were divided into two groups, "small" and "big" according to their age, and taking turns one group went walking on the shoreline with their teacher to look for shells or other interesting elements to observe and discuss, while a marine biologist conducted with the other group a brief lecture on the marine environment, giving information and curiosity on its inhabitants. The theme of plastic pollution was central in the questions of the participants, since along the shoreline it was easy to find plastic debris and trash. Using an anatomic model of a fish, some shells of molluscs and samples of plankton, the childrens had the chance to actively observe and understand morphology and ecology of the Adriatic sea living form. The "small" kids were also entertained with drawings of fishes to colour, while the "big" were amused by the microscope observations and tried to identify the plancton using the material provided.

Name of event:	The Saracen tower and its treasures
Date:	Wednesday 7 th September, 9.30 AM
Event type:	Guided tour and laboratory
Event venue:	Bellaria - Saracen tower
Short description of the event:	Visit to the Saracen tower and the Shell's Museum. Workshop on mollusks, with identification of shells.
Speakers speeches, brief summary and conclusion:	A local guide introduced the activity with the history of the Saracen Tower, the sighiting point to protect the city of Bellaria from the invasion of the pirates from the sea. Inside the Tower is hosted the Museum of Shells, with a large display of shells and specimens of marine invertebrates from the Adriatic. The kids were amused by the different forms and colours of the shells, and asked questions about the way of life of the animals. Moreover the guided tour moved outside, in the garden of the Tower, where are located in display some reconstructions of the ancient "vele al terzo", the traditional ancient sails of the Adriatic. Some of the partecipants already knew the history and characteristics of those sails, so it was possibile to actively include them in the explaination of their colours, drawings and functions. To conclude the activity it was proposed a laboratory of descripition and recognition of some shells, with each kid partececipating having to depict the identikit of a shell using the provided cards. All the children and also the educators who accompanied them showed interest and appreciation for the activities.
