Purpose of the event (What was the objective?)	The Conference, held in Ferrara and online, was organised by the Interreg Italy-Croatia Programme, aimed at showcasing the results achieved by the 11 Strategic projects, highlighting the synergies with other funds that they were able to create during the project implementation. Future "Operation of Strategic Importance" were discussed, presenting their main features and the approach chosen by the Interreg Programmes.
Short description of the event (what happened during the event?)	The conference began with institutional greetings from the Emilia-Romagna Region, Veneto Region, University of Ferrara, Croatian Ministry, Italian Ministry and the European Commission DG Regio. Then there was the presentation of the results of the Strategic Projects co-financed by the Program: Innovamare, STREAM, AdriaClim, Firespill, MARLESS, TAKE IT-SLOW, CASCADE, ARGOS, SUSPORT, FRAMESPORT and MIMOSA from which it emerged how the Programme 2014-2020 encourages cross- border cooperation among the territories of the two Countries overlooking the Adriatic Sea "to increase the prosperity and the blue growth potential of the area by stimulating cross- border partnerships able to achieve tangible changes" in the fields of blue innovation, climate change adaptation, environment, culture and transport. In this cross-fertilization framework the Port Network Authority of Eastern Adriatic Sea, LP in SUSPORT, presented the results of the project and the importance of the cross- border cooperation for the achievement of the results in the field of decarbonization in the cross-border area.
