Event summary

On 23rd September 2021 the CEI-ES organised jointly with two other EU – funded projects, ICARUS and E-CHAIN project a promotional event to present to the audience some of the innovative pilot actions and solutions planned in the project to improve intermodal transport among the two countries. The focus was also placed on how Covid19 has affected the transport sector and what can be done to encourage change of behaviour.

Audience

The event was attended by stakeholders of all three projects, starting from 2 representatives of the Croatian ministry of transport, several representatives of universities, 3 representatives of regional organisations, 2 regional public authorities, 1 public transport operator and 5 companies.

Press involvement

A press release was provided before the event and an article was published on project and partners websites and social media.

Event outcomes

Originally the present event was supposed to be organised as a kick-off side event, to introduce the MIMOSA project to the audience and start involving main stakeholders. However, due to the COVID-19 restrictions the event was postponed and organised jointly with the other two EU projects, to share common results and set the ground for future synergies and results' capitalisation.



To decongest the passenger traffic in peak season, the pilot action consist in the implementation of **new smart technological and advanced solutions to smooth passengers' flows in the port area.**


The pilot action addresses both the efficiency as well as the security dimension
