The research (National Plan for the Coastal Passenger Liner Shipping System, 2018 and FRAMESPORT - IUAV University, 2021) results show that there is no standard for the ports of the Republic of Croatia.

In this sense, we should distinguish between:

- (a) a standard of technical requirements in ports providing high-speed craft lines, ship lines or ro-ro lines, and
- (b) a standard of services in those ports.

The technical requirements that are to be taken into consideration are:

- a possibility of docking the vessels in the port in relation to its characteristics,
- an adequate level of port security in all weather conditions, and
- an adequate land waiting area with unhindered traffic while waiting for boarding, as well as embarking and disembarking of vehicles and passengers.



Within the FRAMESPORT pilot project we plan to use:

- New generation of video surveillance (automatic boat tracking, infrared vision, AI - boat recognition ...)



- a new type of radio frequency-based sensor for automatically indicating busy docks
