The project is focused on field research in the fishing port sector, simultaneously within the collection and systematization of knowledge tools already available. This in order to carry out an indispensable mapping which can represent a useful tool to execute an analysis of the state of the Apulian ports that considers the existing ones, but at the same time represents a useful basis for the development of related activities.

The project activities are: study, analysis and design of Apulian ports to have a photograph of the state of the art. The obtained results will allow planning of interventions and activities in the areas / ports / landings identified in the regional territory, only about fishing aspects.

The actions of this project will be carried out in the form of cooperation between the Apulia Region and ASSET agency.

One of the main deliverables is the creation of waste collecting points that can improve the management/organizational systems and the reduction and recovery of the use of materials plastics, with the aim of preventing their subsequent dispersion into the sea and breaking down the microplastics.

It is possible to apply this method to the touristic aspects of Adriatic ports.
