General introduction and remarks on the FRAMESPORT project

- FRAMESPORT project aims to perform a coordinated initiative supporting an integrated and sustainable development of small ports from a strategic perspective, thus allowing them to be pro-active socio-economic drivers of the development in the Adriatic coasts.
- Such a strategic objective calls for a multifaceted approach, including both the adoption of concrete pilot actions as well as the identification of priority themes to be promoted within the overall strategy.
- Priorities will be individuated by means of a bottom-up approach, involving local and national stakeholders since the project inception phase. Partners, which have been chosen in order to guarantee a wide territorial approach, will address planning and management topics, business models implementation, enhancement of training and competence, as well as develop ICT tools and services, thus supporting an effective development of small ports in the whole IT-HR area.
- Furthermore, a tailor-made ICT platform will collect and systematize relevant key data on small ports to be shared as starting point for any further development. FRAMESPORT will build on existing knowledge and capitalize the results of pilot initiatives by integrating them into a new strategic framework boosting small-scale maritime nodes' performances along the Adriatic coasts.

The brief from the stakeholders' meeting

May 11th 2022

Marche Region/Italy

San Benedetto del Tronto

The meeting was held in the city of San Benedetto del Tronto to involve some selected stakeholders based in the center-south of the Marche Region, in order to gather a direct input on the small ports' phenomenon.

More specifically, in this occasion SVEM represented by Tablino Campanelli, member of the Board of Directors, met the Mayor of San Benedetto del Tronto, the Commander of the Coast Guard of San Benedetto del Tronto and the President of the Central Adriatic Port Authority.

At least 2 technical meetings are going to be organized per each region/county in order to meet relevant stakeholders and observers with the main aim of confronting information sources and data to be collected regarding the small port phenomenon and available best practices.

1.2. Organization of the stakeholders' meeting

- A meeting was held on the premises of the Municipality of San Benedetto del Tronto.
- The event consisted of a meeting among the participants, hosted by the Mayor of San Benedetto del Tronto in order to discuss about the implementation of interventions and projects in the port of San Benedetto.
- The meeting consisted of a brief presentation of the FRAMESPORT project and a further discussion on the implementation of possible initiatives and opportunities for the development of small ports in the Marche Region, with particular attention to the local port of San Benedetto del Tronto.

2. Meeting agenda

- **Collaboration between the Central Adriatic Port Authority and the Municipality of San Benedetto del Tronto in the implementation of interventions and projects in the port area of the city.**

In the framework of the new Pilot Action 4.3, a Member of SVEM Board of Directors was invited to the meeting held at San Benedetto del Tronto on the 11th of May 2022 to talk about the FRAMESPORT project strategy and the pilot action addressed to the macro-theme of spatial planning and management with an updating of the context analysis and specific insights useful for proposing strategic actions for the enhancement of the Marche region's ports network in the context of the Adriatic sea. Through the new pilot action 4.3, SVEM intends to carry out an analysis and a study aimed at understanding the system of tourist ports of Marche Region and analyzing their needs in terms of growth and sustainability. This action is useful for providing new elements to support the updating of planning and management of tourist ports in the Marche, according to the regional tourism policy.

The following functional ports / marinas are identified: Gabicce Mare, Pesaro, Fano, Senigallia, Ancona, Numana, Civitanova Marche, Porto San Giorgio and San Benedetto del Tronto.

The central theme of the visit was the collaboration between the Authority and the Municipality of San Benedetto del Tronto in the implementation of interventions and projects in the port area of the city. The mayor of San Benedetto del Tronto underlined the intention of the Administration to give new value to the port area, carrying out interventions to strengthen the fishing sector, such as those in progress i.e. fish market wholesale, but also with collateral activities, such as fish and fishing tourism and introducing accommodation and entertainment facilities, all through projects with the Central Adriatic Port Authority and in compliance with the provisions of the Port master plan and in full collaboration with

Institutions, other regional actors, port operators to encourage the development of growth opportunities.

2.1. Attendees at the meeting

The meeting registered a total number of 4 participants from 4 entities, of which n. 2 Local public authorities, n. 1 Enterprise, n. 1 Operator of Multimodal logistics hubs.
