FRAMESPORT is a project co-financed by Italy-Croatia CBC Programme, the financial instrument supporting the cooperation among the two European Member States territories overlooking the Adriatic sea. The project will perform a coordinated initiative supporting an integrated and sustainable development of small ports in a strategic perspective, thus allowing them to be proactive socio-economic drivers of the development in the Adriatic coasts.

FRAMESPORT: the final event at Venice Boat Show 2023

***FRAMESPORT, the Interreg Italy-Croatia project will end in style: the actions performed and results achieved will be presented at the Venice Boat Show (31st May – 4th June 2023)***

The 4th edition of the **Venice Boat Show**, the most important Boat Show of the Adriatic and Eastern Mediterranean, is about to kick off: five days dedicated to the passion for navigation, counting on constantly increasing numbers and focusing on green aspects, which are increasingly relevant year after year. **From 31st May to 4th June** the historic framework of the Arsenale di Venezia will host more than 220 exhibitors who will bring to the "city of water" 300 boats, moored along over 1.100 meters of docks.



In this international context, the FRAMESPORT project (*“FRAMEwork initiative fostering the sustainable development of Adriatic Small PORTs”*) will be presented to the public of professionals and amateurs with its **final conference** that will retrace genesis, objectives and results reached within the Italy-Croatia cross-border project, whose formal closure will be the next 30th June.

The event, titled **“For a sustainable development of Adriatic small ports. FRAMESPORT project final conference”**, will be held next **Wednesday, the 31st of May from 1PM to 6PM** at the **CNR ISMAR auditorium (Arsenale – Tesa 104)** and it will be open to the public.



Mr. Pierpaolo Campostrini, managing director of CORILA, lead partner of the project, will open the event followed by many relevant speakers that will take the floor during the conference: from the representatives of the Interreg Italy-Croatia programme, to the competent authorities of some of the Italian and Croatian territories involved in the project who will describe their experiences and points of view on the nautical and tourism sectors as drivers for the local development.

A round table session dedicated to the pilot actions developed within the project will be also held; this will be the occasion to discuss some of the concrete effects that these actions had on the territory and local businesses.

The event will close with a presentation of the new strategic approach proposed by FRAMESPORT for the sustainable development of the small Adriatic ports and an introduction to the innovative digital portal developed within the project and available at [www.framesport.eu](http://www.framesport.eu).

The main actors of FRAMESPORT will be available for the whole duration of the Boat Show at the **dedicated stand (Tesa 90)** to discuss details of the project, pilot actions, developed ICT tools and future initiatives.
