Event Overview:

The "Anche tu sei la Protezione Civile" event, organized by COPE in collaboration with the Gran Sasso Volunteer Civil Protection Association as part of the Firespill project, was held on June 24, 2023, at the Convent of Santa Maria di Monte in Castilenti, Teramo.

The event garnered significant participation from both military and civilian authorities from the region.

During the event, various aspects of the Firespill project were highlighted, including its positive impact on the region, the launch of the Telegram bot, educational and awareness initiatives in schools regarding disaster prevention and management (such as earthquakes and wildfires), and the vital role of Civil Protection for the safety of a community and its territory.

Purpose:

The primary purpose of the event was to showcase the outcomes and achievements of the Firespill project to a diverse audience, including local authorities and stakeholders.

Raising awareness about civil protection measures and the importance of preparedness was a key objective. Educating the public about disaster risks and response strategies helps build a resilient community.

But the event also was aimed at addressing and discussing regional policies on the sphere of civil protection corps intervention. It aimed to underline the importance of disaster preparedness and response, emphasizing the role of the community in safeguarding the region against natural disasters.

Moreover, it served as a platform to disseminate information, share best practices, and raise awareness about Civil Protection efforts and disseminate valuable information about civil protection efforts and best practices in disaster management.

Moreover, by involving local authorities, the event sought to foster collaboration and cooperation between the project and government bodies responsible for civil protection and disaster management.

Target Groups Involved:

The event attracted a wide range of participants, including military and civilian authorities, representatives from local communities, students, and volunteers from various Civil Protection Associations.

By engaging such a diverse audience, the event effectively reached key stakeholders and community members who play essential roles in disaster management and response.

Achievements:

The event was instrumental in achieving several key milestones. It successfully presented the accomplishments of the Firespill project, highlighting its positive impact on the community.



It provided an opportunity to engage in discussions about regional policies related to civil protection interventions. This dialogue could lead to improvements in disaster preparedness and response strategies.

Furthermore, the distribution of 37 merit recognitions to Civil Protection volunteers from various associations who recently assisted in Emilia Romagna following a severe flood underscored the dedication of these volunteers.

Additionally, the provision of 41 personal protective equipment devices to qualified volunteers who completed specialized wildfire training courses, as part of the Firespill project, was a significant achievement in the enhancement of disaster response capabilities.
