In the framework of the Firespill project, Cope organized a roundtable meeting that took place on April 29, 2021, concerning the project. The meeting involved various stakeholders, including volunteer associations from the Civil Protection sector, the Regional Council of Civil Protection Volunteers, and a specialist in radiocommunications.

a) **Purpose of the Meeting:** The primary purpose of the world cafe/workshop was to present and define the key objectives and strategies for Fire Fighting pilot concepts to target groups. Specifically, the meeting aimed to outline the details of training pathways for volunteers and the development of digital social tools. These initiatives were seen as critical precursors to the successful implementation of the project's pilot phase. The meeting served as a platform for stakeholders to collectively shape the project's direction and goals.

b) **Target Groups Involved:** The meeting brought together three primary target groups:

- Volunteer Associations of the Civil Protection Sector: These organizations represent the dedicated individuals who volunteer their time and expertise during emergencies and disasters.
- Regional Council of Civil Protection Volunteers: This governmental body plays a crucial role in coordinating and supporting volunteer efforts in the region.
- Specialist in Radiocommunications: The presence of a radiocommunication specialist underlined the importance of effective communication during emergency responses.

c) **Achievements and Deliverables:** The meeting's key deliverables referred to achievements in the following ways:

- **Training Pathways for Volunteers:** The meeting facilitated the initial planning and conceptualization of training programs for volunteers. These pathways aimed to ensure that volunteers receive comprehensive training in areas such as disaster management, first aid, communication, and crisis response protocols. This achievement was pivotal in preparing volunteers for their roles in future emergency situations.
- **Project Pilot Phase:** Although not directly initiated during the meeting, the discussions and decisions made regarding training pathways and digital tools paved the way for the subsequent launch of the pilot phase of the Firespill project. The meeting served as a crucial steppingstone towards realizing the project's practical implementation.


