WP3 responsible partner PP1 Abruzzo Region from the project start encountered institutional issues that lead partner and JS was informed about. Beside mentioned, pandemic situation affected an overall project implementation, including also activities in the frame of the WP3. Focus of this work package is ESRS Green Paper – a strategic document containing a set of policy recommendations for a more efficient, harmonized and homogeneous emergency services aiming at standardized cross border procedures to tackle risks. A final version of this document was shared by responsible partner PP1 Abruzzo Region in May 2023, so the rest of the partnership had relatively short time to organize Local Capacity Building interventions to present and discuss the ESRS Green Paper.

This report contains information from the partners which have implemented local capacity building interventions. Half of the partnership implemented this activity and organized an event till the formal project duration, but the rest also continued with implementing this activity after the project end since the Green Paper was lately distributed.

LP and PP13 had a joint local capacity building intervention in the frame of the project final conference *Crisis management and communication* which was held in Split in June. On the *Croatian counties/cities disaster risk reduction platform* meeting Green paper was presented and based on this event, Split Dalmatia signed Adoption Protocol prepared by PP1 and PP9.
