## Directions and accommodation

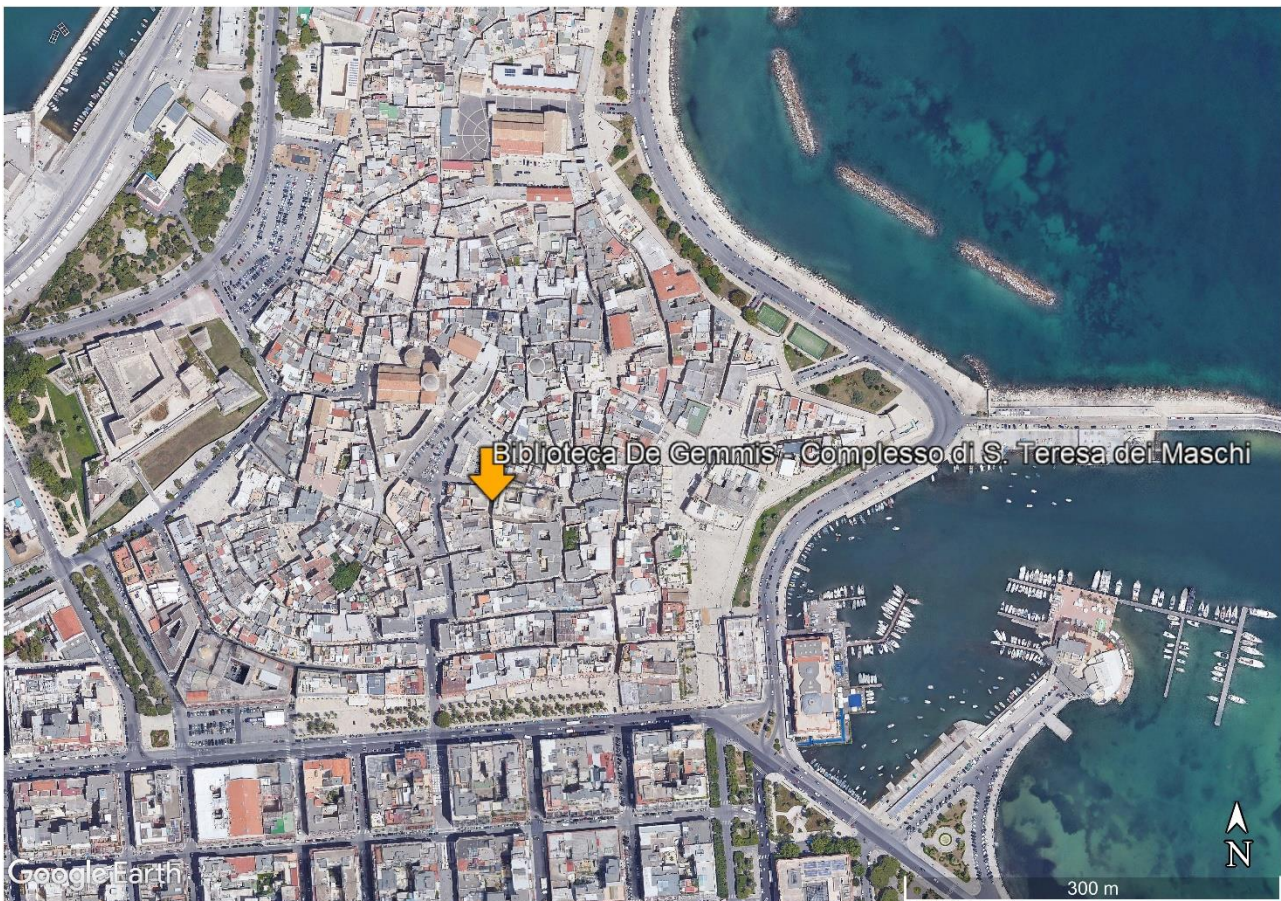
### How to get to the conference venue

Biblioteca De Gemmis (Complesso di S. Teresa dei Maschi – Strada Lamberti, 4).

From the central train station to the venue: 15' walk along Via Sparano da Bari and across the old town.

From the Bari airport:

- to the central train station by bus in 30' (<https://www.autoservizitempesta.it/servizi-orari-bus-navetta/>)
- to the central train station by train in 20' (<https://www.ferrovienordbarese.it/home>)

## Information about Covid-19 restrictions

Please find information for travellers entering Italy [here](#).

In short, travellers coming from EU countries and other countries in [List C](#) must:

- **fill in the [Digital Passenger Locator Form](#)** before entering Italy;
- **provide the [EU Digital Covid Certificate](#)** in one of the following languages: Italian, English, French or Spanish, showing one of the following conditions:
  - having completed the prescribed anti-SARS-CoV-2 vaccination cycle, or
  - having recovered from COVID-19 (the certificate of recovery is valid for 180 days from the date of the first positive swab), or
  - having taken a negative molecular or antigen swab test within 48 hours prior to entering Italy.

**Additionally, travellers entering Apulia should fill in the [regional declaration form](#)** and send the automatically generated pdf to [sorveglianza.coronavirus@asl.bari.it](mailto:sorveglianza.coronavirus@asl.bari.it).

Failure to submit even just one of these documents entails self-isolation at the address indicated on the Passenger Locator Form for 5 days, at the end of which an antigen or molecular swab test will have to be carried out.

The certificate of completion of the vaccination cycle must include one of the four vaccines approved by the European Medicines Agency:

- Comirnaty by Pfizer-BioNtech
- Moderna
- Vaxzevria
- Janssen (Johnson & Johnson)

If you need to take a rapid antigen test during your stay in Bari, you can do so in a pharmacy, which will release a Covid Certificate valid for 48 hours. There are many pharmacies at walking distance from the conference venue. The following have confirmed a cost of 15 €, without need for booking in advance:

- Farmacia Boccuzzi (Corso Vittorio Emanuele, 149)
- Farmacia Melillo (Via Ruggero il Normanno, 80)
