The topic of the seminar was "The MSC certification program for sustainable fisheries: tools and opportunities".

The seminar was held by Ms. Ilaria Vielmini, the representative of MSC (Marine Stewardship Council) which is an international, independent and nonprofit organization, whose mission is to use its eco-label and fishery certification program to contribute to the health of the world's oceans by recognizing and rewarding sustainable fisheries practices. Since the presentation was on Italian language, for translation purposes, the Istrian County hired a simultaneous translator from Italian into Croatian language.







At the Webinar Ms. Ilaria Vilemini presented the mission and the program of MSC, MSC numbers and sustainable fishery standards, as well as the process of certification.

At the end of the webinar, the discussion was opened.


Conslusion:


