EVENT DESCRIPTION

Resilience is necessary for Adriatic coast communities and RESPONSe project has set the strategies to adapt to climate change in the area: a regional focus was made on November 30th in Lignano Sabbiadoro, one of the project pilot cities, where energy and climate transition was presented as an opportunity for Adriatic regions.

Despite climate change scenarios, local communities have the chance to actively work for their future: this is what Lignano Sabbiadoro municipality is doing thanks to the SECAP studied with the experts of APE FVG. Local engagement needs to be supported by regional strategies for climate neutrality.

City Mayor Luca Fanotto welcomed the audience; then PP's representatives, Ivan Curzolo – INFORMEST and Matteo Mazzolini APE FVG explained how energy transition is an opportunity for coastal areas.

A focus on climate scenarios in the Adriatic was made by Anna Lutman - ARPA FVG. Lignano Sabbaidoro SECAP was presented through a double interview to Lignano Sabbiadoro representatives, Luca Fanotto e Cristina Driusso, with scientific support of APE FVG. At the end FVG Region commitment to climate neutrality was presented.
