





The Port Network Authority of the Eastern Adriatic Sea is a beneficiary of the project "REMEMBER – Restoring the Memory of Adriatic ports sites. Maritime culture to foster Balanced Territorial growth" co-financed by the Italy – Croatia CBC Programme 2014 – 2020 Interreg V.A.

**Project Objectives and Activities**

REMEMBER aims at promoting the shift toward sustainable tourism and blue growth in the Programme area through the valorization of the important maritime tangible and intangible cultural heritage of the following eight Adriatic Italian and Croatian port cities: Ancona, Venice, Trieste, Ravenna, Rijeka, Zadar, Dubrovnik and Split.

Within REMEMBER, the Port of Trieste will realize a virtual museum enhancing accessibility to digitalized cultural and historical contents of the port (i.e. photos) in order to raise the awareness and the knowledge on the historical social and cultural links between ports and cities. Furthermore, a permanent exhibition will be set up in the headquarters of the Port Authority of Trieste.


The REMEMBER Virtual Museum will allow to share common features and tales concerning the historical and cultural heritage of the port cities from the two shores of the Adriatic Sea.

Starting from a methodological framework shared among the partners, and with the aim of creating an innovative cultural product that, on the one hand, be suitable to different groups of visitors, by origin and age group, and on the other, can be further developed over time, the Port of Trieste has identified some themes to be explored within its virtual museum:

1. Traditions and culture of the port-city (intangible heritage): the evolution of port labour and professions connected to maritime shipping; the role of the port of Trieste in coffee trade and processing.
2. Socio-economic relationships of the port-city (intangible heritage): the role played by the Austro-Hungarian Empire in the growth of the port and its historical legacy with respect to the demographic, linguistic and cultural fabric of the city: the





**Projekt REMEMBER**


Projekt REMEMBER: RESToring the MEMORY of Adriatic ports sites. Maritime culture to foster Balanced TERRitorial growth / Oživljavanje uspomene Jadranskih luka. Morska kultura za poticanje uravnoteženog teritorijalnog rasta.

Opći cilj projekta je poticanje prijelaza prema održivom turizmu i plavom razvoju kroz valorizaciju pomorske kulturne baštine u osam talijanskih i hrvatskih lučkih gradova, kao važnom pokreću konkurenčnog i uravnoteženog razvojnog pravca. Projektom su obuhvaćeni Ancona, Venecija, Trst, Rovinj, Rijeka, Žadar, Dubrovnik i Split, od kojih su njeni četiri uvršteni na listu svjetske baštine UNESCO-a. U projektu sudjeluje deset partnera s multidisciplinarnim iskustvima i kompetencijama.

Projekt cilja i na povećanje atraktivnosti lokalnih gospodarstava korištenjem ICT-a za digitalizaciju kulturnih sadržaja, diferencijaciju turističke ponude kako bi se smanjila sezonalnost i otvaranje novih poslova kojima se povezuju digitalne i kulturne kompetencije. Prekogranična suradnja usmjerena je i na suočavanje s izazovima koji prate opstanak jadranske pomorske kulturne baštine: masovni priliv turista tijekom vrhunaca sezone, smanjivanje kvalitete odnosa između luka i gradova, onečišćenje okoliša zbog svakodnevnih lučkih aktivnosti te gubitak tradicije i običaja nedovoljno valoriziranih u lokalnim razvojnim strategijama. Ukupna vrijednost projekta je 2.813.460 eura koji se finančira sredstvima programa Interreg Italija-Hrvatska.






