


The rationale behind the programme is the same as that of the project developed by the Ports of Venice and Chioggia, together with seven other coastal towns on the two banks of the Adriatic.





The initiative forms part of the European Maritime Day framework and the #FestaEuVenezia2022, with involvement from the Europe Direct Office of the Municipality of Venice.



Venice hosted one of the main international trade fairs dedicated to boating. The exhibition venue was the Arsenale of Venice, a symbol of the centuries-old military domination of the Serenissima Republic of Venice and the beating heart of its naval industry. 


