#### Summary

The Final project event was organized by PP2 Veneto Region at its premises on 17<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> June 2022. The aim of the event was to present the results achieved within the project, with a particular focus on the pilot actions implemented at cross-border level, as well as to create a space for discussion on future opportunities for the development of the territories involved in the project.

The first day of the event entailed the organization of a Conference with interventions from the partnership on the abovementioned topics. In particular, Fausta Bressani – Regional Director for Culture (Veneto Region), introduced the event welcoming the participants and presenting the agenda for the day.

Roberto Cantagalli – Project Manager (Municipality of Comacchio), presented the main achievements at project level, with a specific focus on the Municipality of Comacchio.

A specific intervention by *Angela Nazzaruolo* – *Delta 2000* was dedicated to the presentation of the events organized by the partnership, and more in general, on the communication activities implemented to ensure the spreading of awareness on the objectives of the project among the identified target groups.

Ada Gabucci and Federico Rosa introduced the digital community platform developed within VALUE and the activity of mapping of the cultural heritage of the territories involved.

On the second half of the conference, space was left for the presentation of the implementations in the pilot areas of the project, through the speeches of *Marco Bruni (Municipality of Comacchio)* on the Spina Open Air Archaeological Park and on the digital historical archive of Pomposa Abbey, of *Alberta Facchi (Director of the National Archaeological Museum of Adria)* on the digitalization and 3D archaeological glass route from the Roman period, and on the play and educational facilities at the National Archaeological Museum, of *Karmen Surdić (Town of Cres)* on the restoration of a network of historical paths on the Island of Cres, of *Anamarija Brali (Museum of Kaštela City)* on restauration of the fortification system on the Balavan hill, of *Milijana Borojević (City of Korčula)* on the restoration of a historical building related to Marco Polo on the island of Korčula.

Sandro Polci dedicated his intervention on the role of the Cultural Districts with a focus on the Po Delta area, presenting the results of the activities carried out and reflecting on the future prospects for the development of the territory and the valorization of its cultural and environmental heritage.

Closing the conference, an intervention from *Silvia Comiati (Italy-Croatia Interreg Programme – Head of Joint Secretariat)* on the role of culture and sustainable tourism in the Interreg Italy-Croatia Programme 2021-2027.



On the second day of the event, PP2 Veneto Region organized a boat trip to the archaeological sites of the Northern area of the Lagoon of Venice.
