The "COASTING-Coastal integrated governance for sustainable Tourism" project, funded by the Interreg_MED Programme, aims to enhance the effectiveness of a multilevel governance tool based on the experience of Contrat de Baie(Coast Contract) of Marseille. The Final Conference and steering committee, held in November in Ragusa, was planned as an opportunity to discuss on the project results at regional and international level in order to start a debate on the development of further collaborations and synergies. Moreover, the meeting was the occasion to present two relevant documents: a formal document for improving institutional actions towards sustainable tourism that was signed by each partners' organizations, and an Agreement for the sustainable coastal development in the province of Ragusa that was signed by each mayor of the nine (9) municipalities involved in Sicily Region. Besides, a special session was devoted to the discussion on the networking activities and sharingstrategies for future project applications in the Mediterranean wide area. During this, UNICAM was invited as one of the speakers to present its experience within the CREW project. In particular, UNICAM focused the presentation on its role in leading all PPs to the setting up of the Observatory and the Cross-border strategy on protection and management of Italian and Croatian coastal wetlands. As results, the two projects were seen as complementary, since they shared a similar methodology based on multilevel governance tools (Coast Contract and Wetland Contract), and so for the future, it will be possible to propose collaborations among partners involved to strengthen the multilevel governance tools such as Coast and Rivers contracts.
