DETAILS

The presentation was held both in Italian and English and was simultaneously translated for the audience in both languages accordingly.

The focus of the presentation during the first part was on the the importance of a river contract in the area, the project path, the action plan, document of intents and the 10 steps for achieving the signature of the river contract. Following the presentation of this, the expert continued by giving detail on the participants, the number, institutions and the way each participant was involved. Following that, the expert continued by giving detailed information on the legislation and the application of river contracts in Marecchia and the detailed action plan with actions and adjustments made in time.

During the second part of the meeting the River contract of Marecchia was explained in detail and each part of it enabled a very interesting Q&A among the audience and the expert involved.

During the last part of the visit, the group was brought to the site and was able to see and visit the River with further explanations and details of what was said and explained orally in the morning.
