After welcome regards by Public Institution, County and Ministry representatives and presenting of CREW project goals, a short Neretva video clip was emitted with the focus on the Neretva valley biodiversity, protected areas and species an Natura 2000 sites along with the Ramsar international values (The Neretva River Delta is internationally also recognized as a Ramsar Area – a wetland of international importance which expands over 12.742 ha).





Due to its location, climate and water richness, the Neretva River Delta, with a total area of about 20.000 ha, is one of the most valuable wetland areas in Croatia. It is the largest river mouth in the country and is one of the few remaining wetlands in Europe, consisting of remnants of Mediterranean wetlands with preserved coastal lagoons. Particularly prominent are reedbeds where many endangered species of animals live.

In the area of the Neretva Delta, eight geographically defined areas with a total area of 1.624 ha are protected with the Nature Protection Act (OG 80/13, 15/18, 14/19, 127/19). The delta has also been declared an area of the Natura 2000 ecological network of particular importance to the European Union as a Special Protection Area (SPA) and a Site of Community Importance (SCI), with a total area amounting to about 23.800 ha.

Due to the area's great biodiversity values, the Public Institution for the management of protected natural areas of Dubrovnik-Neretva County (PIDNC) held a series of Territorial Labs in the target area involving various stakeholders, including: public institutions, counties' representatives, civil society organizations, schools, universities, business support organizations and small and medium enterprises. All of this was done with the aim to create an Action plan and sign a Wetland Contract, in which these stakeholders state their determination to preserve the Neretva River Delta. The Wetland Contract was signed on 15th July 2021 in Metković.

The commitment to 46 activities by 19 stakeholders is a result of the long-lasting collaboration between the PIDNC and local stakeholders in the Neretva Delta. Almost all of the activities in the Action plan are activities which the PIDNC has put in the Neretva Delta management plan (i.e. result of the 3rd Territorial Lab). Thus, the stakeholders were familiar with these activities even before the Action plan drafting process started. However, with this Wetland Contract they have made a real commitment for these activities to be fulfilled once the Management plan is endorsed at the beginning of 2022. Thus, the Wetland Contract proved to be enormous added value to the future Neretva Delta Natura 2000 Management Plan.

















Special Ornithological Reserve Palud - Palù "Natura Histrica"

European Regional Development Fund

The event was opened by Silvia Buttignoni, director of the Institution who briefly presented the purpose of the project and read the letter from the Ministry of Economy and Sustainable Development written by Dr Aljoša Duplić, the director of the State Agency for the protection of Environment and Nature. He has stressed that small, yet valuable wetland habitats are present alongside Istrian rocky coast and pointed out their importance. He also confirmed the commitment of the Ministry to take part actively in the work of the Stakeholders' forum, although they are not official signees of the Wetland Contract, but act as supportive member. This is especially important bearing in mind that Wetland Contract paved the path for production of another important management document for the Palud reserve.





Marko Paliaga, Mayor of the City of Rovinj-Rovigno said that the City is committed to preserve its natural resources and stressed the role of wetlands in flood regulation.

Boris Miletić, President of the Istrian County also stressed that protected nature is an invaluable resource for the future development of the County.

Svjetlana Lupret-Obradović, who was coordinating the activities in the Public Institution, presented the whole project, and after that, consultants for the Vitaprojekt d.o.o., Ivana Šarić and Martina Markov explained the whole participatory process that led to signing the Wetland Contract for Palud area.

After this introductory part, a Wetland contract was signed by seventeen signees, from national level authorities to individuals. Its most important part the Action plan, called "Palud – Diversity in Miniature". It defines 17 activities to be conducted in the next 5 years.

Besides signees, there are six other members of the Stakeholder Forum, who didn't sign the Contract but will also take part in the work of its bodies. They all committed themselves to conduct the activities in cooperation and communication.

IUAV Laguna di Nord Venezia

30 signatories, 18 planned actions declined into 76 specific activities are some of the numbers provided for in the Wet Area Contract for the Northern Lagoon of Venice which signed 15 July 2021.

The Contract is the result of the Interreg Italy-Croatia CREW Project, coordinated by the luav University of Venice, aimed at achieving global effects on the #ecosystems of the coastal wetlands of the Adriatic Sea and on the related socio-economic aspects, overcoming the fragmentations that often jeopardize their integrity, development and conservation.

Citta di San Benedetto del Tronto Sentina Natural Reserve

The contract took the form of 22 actions corresponding to three strategic axes (governance, environment, development) which will be implemented until 2024 when a verification of the achieved results.

The signatories of the document virtually met on Wednesday 28 April 2021, with interventions by various coordinated institutional representatives by the official of the Europe service of the Municipality Sergio Trevisani: by the mayor Pasqualino Piunti to the president of the Sentina Reserve Ruggero Latini, by the regional councilors to the environment of Marche and Abruzzo, Aguzzi and Campitelli, to the lecturer at the IUAV University of Venice Maria Chiara Tosi, CREW project manager, from the municipal officer Serena Sgariglia who followed the project to the president of the Sentina Albano Ferri association, to the agricultural entrepreneur Paolo Rebez Laureati. The meeting can be followed live on the YouTube channel of the Municipality and on the Facebook page of the Municipality.
