As foreseen in the project's Application Form, the Blue World Institute has produced five workshops aimed at high-school pupils and general public, and to be used as complementary material to five workbooks (D2.6.1). The topics cover various aspects (detailed below) and represent presentations that can be used by teachers to supplement teaching the material covered in the five workbooks, in the classroom or individually by general public. Furthermore, the workshops also feature quizzes on the five topics that can be used to test the knowledge gained. The basic concept was produced by the BWI staff engaged on ECOSSE project, whereas external expertise was engaged for development of presentations and quizzes, translations, graphical editing and programming of the quizzes. The workshops were produced in Italian, Croatian and English languages in order to be suitable for the audience in Italy and Croatia, and visitors to the Adriatic as well. The presentations contained within the workshop materials are in .pdf format suitable for viewing on computer screen or tablet. The workshops materials are available for download from the ECOSSE project web page on the Interreg Italy-Croatia website.

The topics of the five workbooks are as follows:
