The seminar is <u>organised</u> by the Interreg Italy-Slovenia <u>Programme</u> 2014-2020 and aims at improving the visibility of project results and their dissemination on the theme "Greener Europe", in the light of the United Nations agenda for sustainable development to combat climate change.

Five projects will be presented under IT-SI - Priority Axis 2.1 Promoting the implementation of strategies and actions to promote energy efficiency and joint low-carbon mobility planning

The <u>Saspas</u> project of which the Municipality of <u>Monfalcone</u> is Lead Partner will also be presented during the workshop.

## Number and type of participants

The first day was attended by 8 institutional participants. The second days was targeted to a specialistic audience (institutions, experts in EU funds, universities) and was attended by 29 participants



### Purpose of the event, outputs and main conclusions

The two days were organised in cooperation with the Friuli-Venezia Giulia Region in the framework of the Open Days 2019, which took place in Brussels from 8 to 11 October 2019 to foster the exchange of good practices and technical expertise in regional and urban development. The first day was aimed at presenting all the European projects of the Municipality of Monfalcone, but especially the SASPAS project, with a focus on innovative activities. The event of 8 October served above all as a moment of exchange of good practices and comparison, in order to gather elements for the development of the projects themselves.

On 09<sup>th</sup> of October the SASPAS project was included in the seminar organised by the Interreg Italy-Slovenia Programme 2014-2020 aiming at improving the visibility of project results and their dissemination on the theme "Greener Europe", in the light of the United Nations agenda for sustainable development to combat climate change.

Alongside the presentation, the Municipality of Monfalcone organised a series of additional meetings and awareness-raising activities with the involvement of the specialised European media and institutional stakeholders, to promote and enhance the results of the authority's projects and specifically those of the cross-border experience aimed at environmental protection and the promotion of good practices.
