Training education "Environmentally-responsible nautics and related services" were held during November in two marinas, Strožanac and Spinut. According to the Covid-19 pandemic prevention measures, the training was organized in two circles.

Local boat owners, nautic tourists, marina staff, ship repair staff and everyone else interested in, were invited to attend the education. The call has been published in marinas, web sites and social networks.

Ranko Milić, M.Sc.E.E, an expert in sustainable development with experience in this field, prepared the training program, PowerPoint presentation according to Curriculum "Environmentally Responsible nautical tourism and related services".

The training has been prepared in detail, informed the participants of various adverse effects on the sea and the environment, and different methods of environmental protection. Participants were also informed about different types of environmental threats caused by human actions and of measures of protection.

Two-days training was held in marina PŠD "Špinut" on 13th and16th November 2020 (9 participants) and 26th and 27th November 2020 (10 participants).

Two-days training was held in marina DŠR "Strožanac" on 6th and 9th November 2020 (6 participants) and 19th and 20th November 2020 (5 participants).

All participants completed Training Evaluation Forms and highly rated the quality of the education.



#### First Educational Activity – 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2021


The first Educational Activity was held at Marina Dorica – main stakeholder of the Municipality of Ancona for the ECOMAP project. Other relevant stakeholders took part to the event called "Un mare di idee per le nostre acque" - such as Alleanza COOP 3.0 and Legambiente that sponsored a second Seabin for the marina. Furthermore, Anywave Safilens – a "conscious" sail boat presented the first-time "On-board responsible crew member" who is accountable for on-board recycling but also collecting spotted plastics left in the sea.

It all started with a press conference in which Michele Polenta – City Councillor for the Municipality of Ancona – highlighted the importance of the ECOMAP project for Marina Dorica and the whole town.

Results and objectives of the ECOMAP project were presented to the public and stakeholders with whom there was a shared vision on the marine environment and how to protect it.

The training mainly focused on recycling for boat owners.













#### Second Educational Activity – 12<sup>th</sup> May 2022

The second Educational was held at Marina Dorica – main stakeholder of the Municipality of Ancona for the ECOMAP project. The event called "Think blue. Stop Sea Pollution" started with greetings from Michele Polenta – City Councillor for the Municipality of Ancona and Alessandro Domogrossi – Director of Marina Dorica.

The training focused on the impact of plastics and micro-plastics on the sea and marine environment by Prof. Francesco Regoli from the University of Ancona. Prof. Carmela Vaccaro highlighted the importance of good practices for waste management in small ports and beaches related to the ECOMAP project. Filippo Ugolini from Garbage Group presented the company's plan of action to tackle maritime and port wast in light of the new European and Italian regulations.

Fabio Vallarola from the Municipality of Ancona presented the billboards acquired within the ECOMAP project and Clara Tiberi made a general overview on the results achieved by the project.

Alessandro Domogrossi completed the training with the ISPS code. (Presentation as annex).

During the event the water pump on trolley for boat black water and the KIT to prevent oil spilling were presented to the public and boat owners trained on how to use them. Marina Dorica made a video showing how to use the water pump - for those boat owners that could not take part to the event. At the end every boat owner received a KIT.










#### Conclusion

Education "Environmentally-responsible nautics and related services" were held during November in two marinas, Strožanac and Spinut. Because the situation caused Covid-19 virus, training was in two circles. There were 30 participants.

In Italy, education was held in two marinas, Ancona (marina Dorica) and Bibione Mare. In marina Dorica, education was held on 23rd September 2021(32 participants) and 12th May 2022 (37 participants).

In Bibione Mare, education was held 22th and 28th of August 2021 (60 participants).

A total of 159 people were educated through the project.
