D 2.4.1 6 testing site visit programmes

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
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I. Context

In the framework of ADRIGREEN project, 6 testing site visits have been organized by the project partners in order to mainstream the implemented actions and to spread operational and technological solutions that could be easily transferred and adopted on majority of ports and airports located in the Programme area. In particular, testing site visits have been held as key events targeted to stakeholders in the ports & airports transport sector to present the main lessons learnt within ADRIGREEN in terms of operational codes, benefits, weakness, problems to be avoided.


Each port & airport facility participating in the project has organized one testing site visit in their premises during the closing project phase. A number of national stakeholders have been invited in each case (other ports and airports, local and regional authorities, Cruise/ferry companies, Air companies, Enterprises, Research Institutions, other ports and airports located in Adriatic area) to present them with implemented solutions/operating codes/technological innovation to demonstrate their benefits for the community (less congestions, less pollutions), benefits on the passengers who are using both airplane and ferry/cruise (more efficient processing of passengers) but also to raise awareness on the importance of unified and coordinated measures to reduce air and maritime traffic impact on the environment.
