1. E-CHAIN LOCAL PUBLIC EVENT

Following the E-CHAIN Project application form, within the WP2 – Communication, project partners were obliged to organize Public Local dissemination events: Ancona hosted by LP, Dubrovnik hosted by PP9, Venice hosted by PP2, Split hosted by PP8, Trieste hosted by PP4, and Rijeka hosted by PP7.

LP – Municipality of Ancona contributed to the deliverable D.2.4.1. E-CHAIN Local Public Events by organizing local public dissemination event in Ancona, on 21st June 2022, during the last period of project implementation. Event has been held in the hall of Mole Vanvitelliana, Ancona.

On Tuesday, 21st June, 2022, the results of the project “E-Chain” were presented in the hall of the Mole Vantitelliana during a conference organized by the Municipality of Ancona. The conference was moderated by Stefano Campanari from the E-CHAIN project management and hosted seven speakers to present to the public the project contents, backgrounds, outputs and further possible developments.

The councillor Ida Simonella welcomed the participants and underlined the importance of European projects to experiment innovative services. Claudio Centanni, Chief Manager of the urban planning, public building, port, and mobility, added: “Since its start in 2019, E-Chain’ goals coincide with those of the Municipality: upgrade Ancona’s port fruition and experiment a new traffic organisation system.”

The focus of the conference was to present the project output, thus the E-CHAIN platform. With the project support, in the city centre of Ancona, three interactive totems have been installed providing information and public utility services such as trains schedule, maps, and tourist information.

The software developers Marco Cocciarini and Alessandro Caponi presented the platform and how it supports users to plan green trips by checking options with lower environmental impact and allowing them to book the chosen route directly from the partners' websites.

The E-Chain conference continued by giving the floor to important project stakeholders. Guido Vettorel, as development, promotion, and communication manager at the Port System Authority, displayed the importance of the EU project design to support the port area. Giving another perspective, Corrado



Ceccarelli, development manager at Gruppo Amatori, and Vania Bontempi, Vice-president of the tourism and culture section at Confindustria, explained the prospects and opportunities given by European projects for intermodal transport between Italy and Croatia.

The last session of the Conference was dedicated to a Question Time to answer the public questions, to share experiences, and discuss possible follow-up initiatives.

PP4 – University of Trieste contributed to the deliverable D.2.4.1. E-CHAIN Local Public Events by organizing local public dissemination event in Trieste, on 7th April 2022, during the last period of project implementation. Event has been held in Savoia hotel, Trieste.

The event with the title “The E-Chain platform for the sustainability in the Adriatic area. An innovative solution to promote a sustainable flow of passengers between Italy and Croatia” took place in the Savoia Hotel and had the aim to consolidate the network between the project partners and export the E-Chain knowhow to the local authorities and all the interested parties of the Trieste’s city.

The Public event, with a duration of one morning, was designed as a dynamic conference and it was divided in two parts: the first was managed in plenary mode, the second as a round table.

In the plenary part, the E-Chain partner leader introduced the potential and functionality of the E-Chain platform, analyzed from the point of view of B2B, B2C and B2PA. Moreover, a focus on the sustainability of the platform, from an environmental, economic, and social point of view was also proposed to the audience. Whereas the second part of the event was dedicated to the round table with the aim of evaluating the exportability of the E-CHAIN platform from the three Pilot Sites of the project (Venice, Split and Ancona) to the city of Trieste.

The round table achieved the objective of having an heterogenous audience mainly composed by Transport suppliers (even those who aren’t part of the project E-Chain), Public Administration and Tourism suppliers.



The table was managed by a moderator and an assistant. The round table session started with the moderator presentation of the work and introducing the topics focusing on the three keywords of the round table: Connectivity, Green and Experience. Whereas the assistant had the task of managing the screen (the MIRO board), systematizing the information raised during the session. Before proceeding with the short description of the round table discussion, it is emphasized that the proposed approach was the same of the training activities described in the Deliverable 5.1.1 and it followed the Double Diamond Framework.

The public event in Trieste was appreciated both in the organization and in the contents. Indeed, a similar structure was replicated in the Rijeka public event on June 10, 2022.

1. E-CHAIN LOCAL PUBLIC EVENT

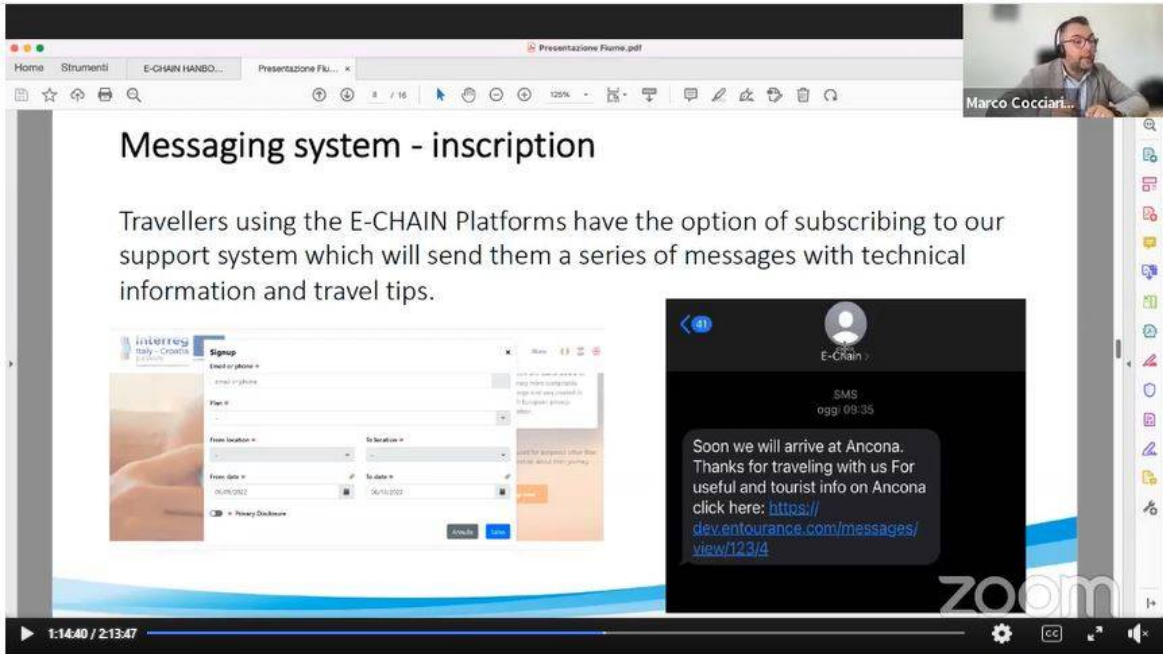
