

1. Event description

The final conference of the project E- CHAIN (Enhanced Connectivity and Harmonization of data for the Adriatic Intermodal Network) Interreg Italy-Croatia 2014-2020 was held on Friday, June 10, 2022 from 09:15 to 12:15 at Hotel Bonavia in Rijeka. The event was organized by the Jadrolinija in close cooperation with LP and the PPs.

3. Description of the speakers' presentations & conclusions

The event began at 09:15 with the registration of participants. During the registration, the participants of the meeting made statements to the media. The first statement was given by Mr. Mladen Koturović, General Affairs Manager at Jadrolinija, and further information on the technical details of the platform was given by Marco Cocciarini, Technical Assistant of the Municipality of Ancona and leading partner of E- CHAIN.

At 09:30, Mr. Mladen Koturović from the company Jadrolinija welcomed the attendees and expressed his satisfaction with the participation in this event.

After the opening speech, Mr. Marco Cocciarini, technical assistant of the Municipality of Ancona, took the floor and told the audience a little more about the project E- CHAIN.

After that, Mr. Alessandro Caponi, technical assistant of the Municipality of Ancona, took the floor and explained the work of the platform E- CHAIN, its advantages and disadvantages, as well as the future development and exploitation plans.

After him, Lorenzo Castelli from the University of Trieste took the floor and spoke about the research carried out as part of the E- CHAIN project, the results of the surveys, the guide created for more sustainable travel and the future plans.

After the presentation of the different elements of the project, there was a coffee break. The coffee break was prepared and served for 28 people and the participants could help themselves to cold and hot drinks and croissants.

At the end of the break, the moderator of the meeting, Mr. Mladen Koturović, announced the second part of the meeting - the round table - and asked the round table participants to introduce themselves.

The participants of the round table were David Brčić, the newly elected Vice Dean for Scientific and Research Activities of the Maritime Faculty in Rijeka, Ivan Dovadžija, representative of the project MIMOSA (MarItime and MultimOdal Sustainable pAssenger transport solutions and services), Matej Plenča, Head of the Center for International Projects of the Maritime Faculty in Rijeka, Vedran Kirinčić, Associate Professor of the Faculty of Engineering, and Mladen Koturović.

At the end of the presentation, the roundtable participants gave their positive/negative opinion on what they had seen and then had time to ask questions. The discussion also revolved around the topic of future application and further development of the platform.

Those present concluded that the idea of the project is good and interesting and that the platform is userfriendly. in addition, they expressed the hope that the platform will continue to be used and develop more and more in the coming years.
