Event summary

Intermodal Transport Cluster organized an online dissemination for the ICARUS project on the 10th of December 2021. During the event, a presentation on the project, its goals and achievements was given, along with a presentation highlighting local results, mainly the pilot platform developed by KIP, as well as a discussion on what these results mean for the future of intermodal transport. After the event, satisfaction survey was sent to all participants in order to collect feedback on the presented pilot platform.

Audience

18 participants were present during the event and since it was public event, no registration was asked so all participants are part of the general public.

Event outcomes


After the initial welcome, introduction of the event and KIP, the team presented the ICARUS project and its main goals. A special focus was placed on the pilot activities and their results. The general presentation was followed by the showcasing of the achievements in Primorje-Gorski Kotar county, related to the pilot action "Boosting intermodal solutions through ICT Web/mobile application for the promotion of intermodal passenger transport". The audience was informed that the platform provides information for all transport means, having regard to the sustainable solutions and it could help shaping the future of transport in the region. After his presentation, Mr. Lenhard showed the educational video about the ICARUS project developed as part of KIP's pilot action and published online.



The second part of the event was dedicated to a question and answer session. A satisfaction survey was sent to the participants to collect their feedback.



Graph 1: How often do the surveyed users use public transport




Graph 2: How much does learning about the availability of public transport services increase the interest in using public transport?






Graph 3: The most useful features of the "How to travel in Primorje-Gorski Kotar" segment






Graph 4: How useful is the information on integrated transport options for the needs of the users?

Through this satisfaction survey, the pilot action was given a very positive review from the participants of KIP's dissemination event where the ICARUS mobility platform was presented and was given to the participants for a chance to try it before filling out the survey. The participants, who use public transport and those who don't, have rated it as a useful tool for sustainable mobility and have highly rated the segments which they consider useful whether it is information on local and regional public transport, integrated public transport, cycling and bike sharing, or new integrated services in the ICARUS regions. The awareness for the need to reduce traffic congestion and to use public transport more often is high among the participants of the survey. The further improvement of transport services and the introduction of new integrated services could influence more of the public to use sustainable modes of transport for commuting. The surveyed users also consider ICARUS mobility platform as an important factor for further developments in the region, and the majority of them (55%) have noted that thanks to the platform, they are more willing to use sustainable transport modes.
