Purpose of the event	After a year of implementing activities focused on the valorization of cultural, industrial, and natural heritage, the Boost5 project, co-funded by Interreg Italy-Croatia Programme entered its final phase. The final conference was held at the City Hall of the City of Rijeka, together with domestic and international partners, where the project's results were presented. An overview of key project activities and results was given to stakeholders and general public, with a look forward to future collaboration in the development of sustainable tourism through the revitalization of rich heritage in the Adriatic area. Short description of the event and key outcomes	Event was jointly organized by PP3 – STEP RI Science and technology park of the University of Rijeka and City of Rijeka. Besides the project partners, a number of stakeholders participated in the event in person, while others also joined online by following the livestream. Stakeholders present in person included mayor of Rijeka, general consul of Italy in Rijeka, representatives of Italian community in Rijeka and also the representatives of organizations managing cultural heritage. After welcome speech by major of Rijeka, Mr Marko Filipović and general consul of Italy, Mr Davide Bradanini, the overview of the project was	



given by Mr Davide de Nicolò from Tecnopolis science and technology park. Next was the presentation given by Ms Anca Daniela Simion from the Joint Secretariat of the Interreg Italy- Croatia Programme, who presented the cluster projects role in making natural and cultural heritage a leverage for sustainable and more balanced territorial development. After that, Mr Dominik Damiš, director of The house of the Halubaj bell ringer presented his initiative of cultural heritage valorisation. Ms Ana Pejdo from the University of Zadar presented the first
2021-27 programming period, was presented by Ms Rachele Ruggiero from SVEM – Development Europe Marche Srl. Finally, the Join the Cross- border Observatory - coordinated management of natural and cultural heritage allowing sustainable territorial development was presented by Mr Massimo Sargolini from the University of Camerino and Ms Raffaella Triponsi from Marche Region.
In total, 99 persons participated in the event: 18 in person 81 online.


