

CFLI visited the Port of Venice on 15th June 2023 in occasion of the hosted within the General Assembly of ITS MARCO POLO ACADEMY MEMBERS that presented the birth of the new Academy of the Sea and Logistics.

In this occasion the main results of DIGSEA project have been presented and three experts of the Port of Venice (Alvise Zerbinati, Francesco Zanon, Mauro Marchiori) have been interviewed about the digitalization issues related to the logistics processes.



"In Italy, we are 25th out of 27 EU countries in terms of human capital related to digitisation. We have software, we have connectivity, we have everything we need, but what we lack is training and a culture of digitalisation within companies. We need training, we need a culture within companies to ensure that digitisation is not just the use of software but becomes part of the business processes with which we operate on a daily basis in ports" was one of the messages conveyed during the study visit.

May 4th – 5th 2023 DIGSEA @ the Adriatic Sea Forum 2023 - Dubrovnik

The Adriatic Sea Forum is the most relevant event dedicated to maritime transport in the Adriatic Sea, focusing on passenger and freight transport. "Green and Smart Ports in the Adriatic-Ionian Region. The decarbonisation and digitalisation of ports and freight transport: the contribution of European territorial cooperation"



DIGSEA final conference was organized by the Port Authority of the Eastern Adriatic Sea in cooperation with the Friuli Venezia Giulia Region and under the auspices of the European Macro-Strategy for the Adriatic-Ionian Region (EUSAIR) in Trieste on 21st June 2023. Over the past few years, the ports of Italy, Slovenia and Croatia been cooperating to improve their environmental have performance and efficiency through telematic solutions, both within the North Adriatic Port Association (NAPA) and in the framework of several projects co-financed by European funds and led by the Port of Trieste. During the conference, the main results of projects "DIGSEA - Digitisation of Multimodal Transport in the Adriatic Sea" and "SUSPORT - SUStainable PORTs" (Interreg Italy Croatia), "ACCESSMILE - Improving the accessibility of the last best for rural and peripheral areas to the main TEN-T nodes in Central Europe through ICT" (Interreg Central Europe) were illustrated. The knowledge developed within the framework of these projects, together with that of the broader project "EALING - European flagship action for cold ironing in ports" (CEF Programme), was pooled by bringing together the experiences of more than thirty ports, freight villages and logistics operators from eleven European countries.
