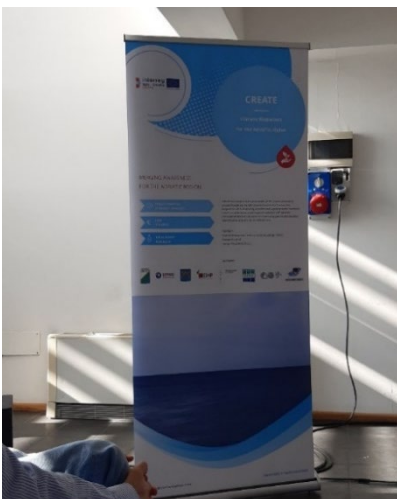


Fig. 4 - View of CREATE workshop Roll up and presentation by Margaretha Breil (CMCC)



5. 1st “European GREEN Conference – EGC 2023”

Croatian Waters (PP6) took part in the first European GREEN Conference, organized by the International Association of Environmental Scientists and Professionals (IAESP) and the Faculty of Food Technology in Osijek with a support of a network of partner institutions (Fig. 17). The event was held in Vodice, Croatia, between May 23 and May 26, 2023.

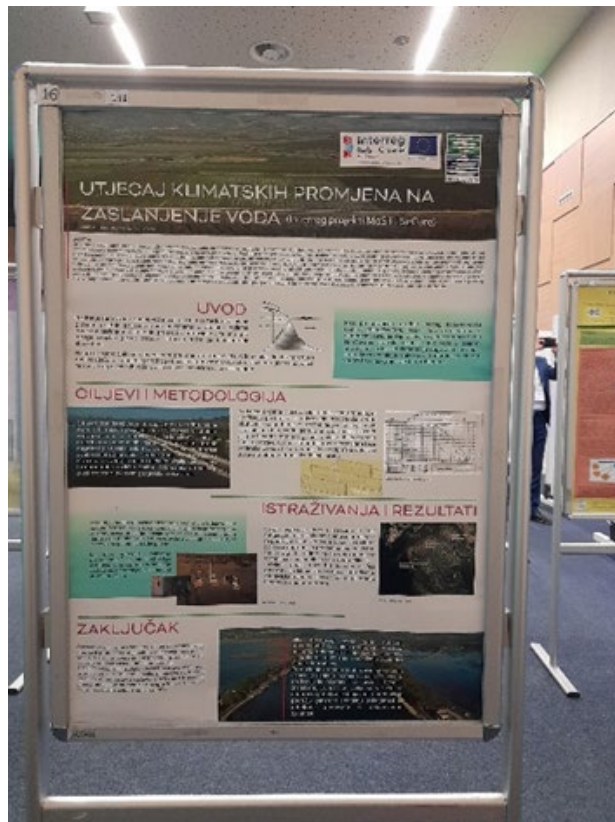


Fig. 18 – The SeCure poster presented by PP6 at the 1st European Green Conference

PP6 presented a poster communication: “Impact of climate change on water salinization (Interreg projects MoST and SeCure)” under thematic area “Climate Change” (Fig. 18). This event aimed at knowledge exchange and networking of scientists and experts, with a focus on the necessity of applying a multi-disciplinary approach in environmental protection and achievement of sustainable development guidelines. The conference was attended by several participants to EU research programmes, with a fruitful exchange of experiences in water and environment management.

6. Horizon Results Booster “UNDER H2O Cluster”

SeCure, specifically LP and PP2, participated in May-June 2023 to the Horizon Results Booster “UNDER H2O Cluster” - Sustainable and Efficient Management of Groundwater. It was a service made available by the EU to research projects that shared common topics.

The activities were carried out with a group consists of 4 projects which are conducting research and providing new technologies in the field of water management systems. Supported by the European Commission’s Horizon Results Booster programme (HRB), RESERVOIR, SeCure, eGROUNDWATER and InTheMed have taken the first step towards forming a Project Group (PG) based on commonalities between their work in this research field.

HRB supports effective transfer of research and innovation project results to policy makers, industry and society by offering various services as dissemination, exploitation strategy and business plan development to projects supported under the 7th Framework Programme (FP7) or Horizon 2020 funding schemes.

The final outcome of the shared activity between the projects and the project partners with the EU agency is a confidential report (Fig. 19) where, based on the project inputs, target stakeholders and dissemination channels are detected and suggested. Based on the analysis in target stakeholders, the HRB service delivery team identified a dissemination network with around 50 contacts and related social media channels identified across the stakeholder groups to start engaging with. This can serve as an important basis for future dissemination activities. The summary of the report is provided in Fig. 20.
