## Thematic Workshop

"How to preserve the Adriatic Sea ecosystem and allow a sustainable exploitation of its resources"

### Thematic workshop in Venice (Italy) 25<sup>th</sup> October 2022

TECHERA project is co-funded by the Interreg Italy-Croatia Cooperation Programme 2014-2020 under Cluster 1 "Connectivity from the sea: data driven solution in the sea economy" and stems from the capitalization of 6 previous projects ADRIREEF, FAIRSEA, ITACA, SUSHIDROP, PRIZEFISH and BLUE KEP that have experimented with innovative data-driven practices and approaches in the context of the blue economy.

The project main objectives are:

- To set up an intersectoral cluster for data sharing;
- To promote smart specialization and advanced technologies;
- To boost attractive and innovative careers in the Blue Economy

The TECHERA WP2's goals are making the project better known to a wide audience and stakeholders, ensuring the transferring of projects' results within the cluster and, most of all, outside of the cluster, making the knowledge generated by projects more accessible and enhancing the visibility of project results. PP2 coordinates the WP with the engagement of ALL partners sharing their work for ensuring the quality of communication.

WP2 includes among its activities 'Online and offline events' (Activity details 2.1). In this context, on 25<sup>th</sup> October 2022, the TECHERA project Thematic workshop took place with all project partners. The event was realised in a coordinated way between RESISTANCE project. The first part of the workshop was dedicated to the presentation of the main results of the previous projects that Techera intends to capitalise on, as well as the context, specific objectives, main activities and expected results of the Techera and Resistance projects.

After an introduction to the event by the TECHERA project representative Ms. Alessia CARIANI (UNIBO), and the RESISTANCE project representative Ms. Andrijana DEDIĆ, (Municipality of Podstrana), experts from ISPRA, Municipality of Ravenna, Veneto Agricoltura, UNIFE, UNIBO National Park of Kornati, IUAV and Emilia-Romagna Region intervened.

During the second part of the workshop, the experts presented "The approaches studied by Techera and Resistance projects:

- 1. New tools for increasing awareness,
- 2. Technological and data-driven innovations,
- 3. Science-stakeholder-policy makers, the triple helix,
- 4. Socio-economic sustainability patterns'.

They reported and described the progress and techniques of their projects under the workshop theme.

Immediately afterwards, a round table discussion took place, entitled "What's next? Exploring new project ideas". Prof. Alessia Cariani and Prof. Giulio Pojana acted as moderators at this round table, where today's problems and new ideas regarding the protection of the Adriatic Sea and its fishing and economic riches were discussed.
