## 1. SUMMARY

HATCH project aims to contribute to increase the awareness also interacting with EUSAIR missions. On the other side, the focus of HATCH project was also about the Marine spatial planning (MSP) directive application and its eventual effect on the protection of the marine environment. MSP is a process introduced by the European Directive 2014/89/EU with the aim of promoting the sustainable growth of maritime economies, the sustainable development of marine areas and the sustainable use of marine resources. It involves therefore a global and integrated approach to planning the use of marine spaces and of their resources. The goal of MSP is to balance different activities that take place at sea or there uses such as fishing, aquaculture, shipping and transportation, recreational use and tourism, energy development and scientific research while protecting at the same time the marine environment and ensuring the long-term sustainability of marine resources. MSP therefore it introduces the need to integrate environmental sustainability and blue economy and is based on the awareness that the health of marine ecosystems is safeguarded protecting seas and oceans is essential not only for the protection of their biodiversity but also to offer long-term sustainability of the same activities and uses of the sea carried out by man.

This event provided a platform to discuss the "implementation" of this directive in the experience of the Friuli Venezia Giulia Region. Our experts highlighted the role of the Italian regions in the implementation of the European directive and analysed the strengths, weaknesses and difficulties of participatory decision-making processes with the various actors involved in the implementation process. The aim has been to hold a constructive discussion on the future developments of this directive, which is subject to periodic re-evaluation. Useful planning tools are also presented such as "Hadriaticum DATA HUB" originated by "Maps 4 MSP" within the "HATCH" project.

## 2. The event

The MSP process involves an important territorial effort as it requires the involvement of government agencies, entities involved in land management, entrepreneurs, non-governmental organizations and community representatives. In fact the planning framework also provides that there is proper use of land so that coastline impacts and pressures are sustainable for the sea. To highlight the efforts and the methodology adopted by Friuli Venezia Giulia region to fulfill the application of the Directive and to highlight the relation that can emerge with the aims of Pillar 1 Blue growth the Agenda of this event was conceived to mix regional and local authorities and person involved in the management of the aquaculture sector as an example of reasoned uses of the marine spaces (day1). Moreover, emerged the relationship between MSP and pillar 3 Environmental Quality in day 2, during which all the aspects of the importance of the preservation of the biodiversity were clearly described by the experts of the Marano lagoon and its transition environment.
