The meeting began at 9.30 am with the institutional greetings of the Project Coordinator and then of the Mayor and the Councilor of the city of Pescara, who emphasized and underlined the strategic value of the project and the excellent results achieved, congratulating all the partners.

Following the project press conference took place in the presence of many journalists and project representatives, during which the Project Coordinator, Ms Paola Di Salvatore, thanked all the partners for the excellent work done, listing all the results obtained.

After a short pause, the presentation phase of the state of the art of the project and the goals achieved began, starting with WP1 and WP2 by the consultants of the Abruzzo Region, IPA Territorial Cooperation Service.

The first to provide the presentation was the project PM, Barbara Trincone, who described all the main actions carried out by the project and the final steps still to be done, such as the third progress report.

Afterwards, Mr Lorenzo Rossi, the Financial Manager, took the floor and presented the progress report, the reimbursement procedure, the financial plan, and all the financial procedures for the project closure.

Then Ms Laura Rosella, Communication Manager, took the floor, illustrating all the actions put in place for the communication and dissemination of the project and its results.

Mr Mato Tomljanovic from the Dubrovnik-Nereva Region took the floor and illustrated the operations performed for WP1, 2, 3 and 5.

At 11.30 started the presentation session of the technical activities (WP3, WP4, WP5) by Mr. Stefano Barbieri and Ms. Ida Maiello from CETEMPS, with the description of the project status and all the technical outputs and deliverables completed, such as the firefighting boat, the wind profiler, the implementation of coastal monitoring data assimilation into a high resolution forecasting model.

Then Mr. Kreso Pandzic exposed all the project activities carried out by PP2, DHMZ, with his presentation.

Mr. Federico Falcini and Mr Guglielmo Lacorata, from National Research Council (CNR) and Institute of Marine Sciences (ISMAR) PP3, presented the results of activity 3.1, Satellite monitoring for coastal impacts of flooding and extreme weather and activity 4.4, set up of high resolution coastal dispersion model close to river outlet.

Then followed a short open discussion on the project and financial status and the Steering Committee Meeting, in which all the partners agreed on the latest activities and the latest deadlines to be completed for the closure of the project.

After the meeting the final event ended with the lunch in a restaurant in Pescara at the presence of every partner and all the people who worked on the Adriamore project.
